## 2005 TAX AND REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES: REPORTS OF ISSUANCE



The 2005 Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes (TRANs) season is in full swing. TRANs are short-term notes primarily used as an interim financing tool to fund an issuer's temporary cash flow deficit. Revenues from property tax payments and other general fund revenues of a single fiscal year are commonly designated as the source of repayment for TRANs.

TRANs are generally issued at the beginning of a fiscal year, maturing in 15 months or less, and often are issued to bridge the time lag between when expenses are paid and tax revenues are collected. An issuer may issue TRANs individually or may elect to include them in a pooled financing structure. Public agencies will use the pooled financing method to reduce the administrative and issuance costs involved in borrowing money, as well as to reap the benefits of improved market access and lower interest rates achieved through economies of scale.

The California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) has received filings on only 327 TRAN issues, 50 percent less than the 649 reported for this same period last year. The chart below shows a 10-year trend of TRAN issuance, and illustrates the decline.

As of July 15, 2005, forty-seven TRANs are set to be issued on an individual basis, amounting to \$2.8 billion. The remaining 280 notes fall under one of 7 different TRANs pools.

## The Bond Market Association Unveils New Website – builtbybonds.org

The Bond Market Association (TBMA) has unveiled a new website dedicated to bringing substantial bond-related information to the public in an easy-to-view and understandable format.

The webpage contains vital data on bond issuance by state, as well as a portal that links to two congressional public finance-related committees, the House Ways and Means Committee and Senate Finance Committee.

The website also showcases the members of the Built By Bonds Coalition. This group of approximately 20 associations spans a wide array of public finance interests, from health care facility financing to state housing authorities. The Built By Bonds Coalition seeks to preserve the ability of state and local governments to finance public projects at the lowest cost possible. Coalition members include organizations representing state and local governments, the insurance industry, municipal bond issuers, professional sports leagues and representatives of bond market participants.

The Built By Bonds Coalition is unified in its opposition to proposals contained in the Joint Committee on Taxation's (JCT) January 2005 report for the Senate Finance Committee titled *Options to Improve Tax Compliance and Reform Tax Expenditure* that would drive up the cost of borrowing for state and local governments. The Coalition's opposition includes, but is not limited to, the provisions to eliminate advance refundings for governmental and 501(c)(3) tax-exempt bonds, repeal the two percent de minimus exemption, impose new rules on pooled financings, and create new informational reporting requirements for tax-exempt issuers.

#### California Counties and Cities Seeing Significant Revenues From Booming Real Estate

California's cities and counties fiscal condition has improved significantly due to record increases in property tax revenues driven largely by the state's residential real estate boom. The California Association of Realtors said the median home price in California hit \$522,230 in May, a 12.5 percent increase from a year earlier.

Although 1978's Proposition 13 shields homeowners from steep property tax increases, the significant increase in the price of homes sold has generated more than a half-decade of hefty annual increases in the total amount of property taxes paid in the state.

Much of the new property tax revenue is generated from the tens of thousands of new houses being built in the state, and from the resale of homes that have appreciated steeply and return to tax rolls at their higher value.

Local officials in many cities and counties are expecting record increases in the next fiscal year.

The Legislative Analyst's Office predicts a 10.5 percent increase statewide in property tax receipts in California in the coming fiscal year, a dramatic rise in an era when public revenues in general have been sagging and even declining. Local officials say the flow of new revenues could not come at a better time.

Local government revenues received from the state will be reduced by \$1.3 billion beginning in July, the second installment of a deal struck in exchange for Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's support for Proposition 1A's protections for local revenues.

The measure, approved by voters last fall, bars the state from reducing local governments' share of property and sales tax proceeds beginning in the 2006-07 fiscal year.

Two years ago, many cities faced fiscal deficits. Today, many are operating in the black and adding services for the same fast-growing areas that are fueling the boosted revenues. These include improving infrastructure, heath care, and public safety.

Proceeds from the property taxes that homeowners pay are divided among schools, cities, counties, special districts, and redevelopment agencies. Property taxes make up about 11 percent of a typical California city's revenues, according to the League of California Cities. The bulk of cities' revenues come from charges for services such as sewer and water, sales taxes, utility taxes, and other fees.

A study released last week by the University of California, Los Angeles's Anderson School of Management predicted the exploding housing market could cool down later this year or next, and some economists have long feared a housing "bubble" in California could have devastating effects on the economy.

## Senate Finance Chairman to Introduce Bill Repealing Alternative Minimum Tax (AMT)

U.S. Senate Finance Committee chairman Charles E. Grassley and leaders of the tax-writing panel will introduce legislation to repeal the alternative minimum tax (AMT).

Although Grassley did not provide any specifics about when the measure would be introduced or its exact contents, a repeal of the AMT would eliminate the current tax code provision under which interest earned from tax-exempt private-activity bonds is subject to the AMT.

#### MELLO-ROOS AND MARKS-ROOS YEARLY FISCAL STATUS REPORTS

Mello-Roos Community Facilities Districts (CFD) selling bonds after January 1, 1993 and Marks-Roos Local Bond Pools (both authority and local obligations) issuing debt after January 1, 1996 are required to file *Yearly Fiscal Status Reports* (YFS) with the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) by **October 30th** of each year.

Approximately 1,000 Mello-Roos CFD bond issuers are required to report specific information on each bond issue, including fund balances, assessed values, and reported delinquencies or draws on reserves.

More than 700 Marks-Roos pooled participants are expected to file YFS reports on approximately 600 separate bond issues. Reporting entities provide specific information on the year-end fund balances for principal amount of the issuance, reserves, construction and capitalized interest funds, assessed valuation, delinquency, and foreclosure information.

As a reminder, if there are any occurrences of default or draw, Sections 6599.1(c) and 53359.5 of the California Government Code require that any Marks-Roos and/or Mello-Roos Bond participant, including all authorities and local obligors that issue bonds or receive loans (regardless of when sold) must report any occurrence of a non-payment of principal and interest (default) or use of reserve funds (draw) to make principal and interest payments. The data should state the scheduled date the default or draw on reserve occurred, the amount of the default or draw, and any information about the issue that would be of value to those receiving the information.

These reports must be filed with CDIAC within ten days of the event.

#### CDIAC ANNOUNCES NEW TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS

In April 2005, the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) reconstituted its Technical Advisory Committee (TAC). The TAC is an advisory body consisting of public and private finance professionals that offer CDIAC staff expertise, insight, and experience in the areas of public debt and investment matters. TAC members also actively participate as faculty for CDIAC's continuing education programs. CDIAC staff holds meetings with its TAC members generally twice a year; however, members are contacted regularly for assistance throughout the year. TAC members serve a two-year term and may be reappointed.

The TAC is comprised of two sub-committees, the Debt TAC and the Investment TAC, and a member each TAC chairs their respective subcommittee. CDIAC would like to thank Jacquelynne Jennings of Lofton & Jennings (Debt TAC), and Tony Garcia of Wells Fargo Institutional Securities, LLC (Investment TAC), for their continued commitment to serve as chairs of their respective committees.

During a hearing on the Finance Committee's Taxation and Oversight Subcommittee, Grassley said the panel faces two tasks: to increase the current exemption amount from the AMT to make sure that more taxpayers, especially those who are married with children, do not become subject to the tax, and to find a long-term solution for the AMT problem that includes repealing the tax.

Grassley announced his plans as several municipal bond issuer groups have been lobbying both Congress and President Bush's tax reform panel to repeal the provision that subject's interest earned from private-activity bonds to the AMT because it drives up issuance costs by as much as 50 basis points.

Repealing the AMT would enhance market demand for private-activity bonds and increase market efficiency, the groups have said. The AMT was originally enacted in 1970 to ensure that wealthy taxpayers were paying their fair share of federal income tax and was amended in 1986 to include numerous other deductions and exclusions including the interest earned from private-activity bonds.

The AMT has become an increasing problem for middle-income taxpayers in high-tax states, such as New York, where tax deductions and exemptions must be added back to determine if the taxpayer is subject to the AMT. Unless the exemption amount is increased or the whole AMT is repealed, inflationary increases in the deductions and exemptions will make more taxpayers subject to the tax.

Grassley warned that unless it is changed or reformed, 85 percent of families with two or more children would face paying the AMT in 2010.

## Early Repayment of Vehicle License Fee (VLF) Gap Loan: A Welcome Surprise for All Cities

The announcement that the 2005-06 California State Budget will include early, full repayment of the "VLF Gap Loan" is good

news for cities and counties who will now receive this payment earlier than expected. The early repayment also benefits the state because it liquidates a state debt and eases some of the stress that will be felt in next year's state budget.

It is well known that nearly 150 cities and counties securitized the VLF gap loan by selling to investors notes secured by the state's promise to repay. In all, over \$650 million of the \$1.2 billion was securitized, including Los Angeles County's stand-alone securitization. The securitization for all other cities and counties was accomplished through California Communities, the joint powers authority sponsored by the League of California Cities and the California State Association of Counties.

Now that repayment will come early, what happens to the cities and counties that sold their right to receive payments from the state? As it turns out, they'll be winners, too. Many of these agencies received the funds when they were needed to address budget issues in fiscal year 2004-05. And the early repayment means there will be additional interest earnings, above what will be needed to repay the notes. The discounts that local agencies had to accept will be recovered or will shrink considerably.

The repayment funds for the securitized agencies will be invested until the date the notes mature on November 15, 2006. At that time, investors will be paid for the notes they hold. Residual funds, including the unexpected interest earned from the early repayment, will be distributed on a pro rata basis to the agencies that securitized the loan. California Communities is working with bond counsel to determine whether the use of the repayment funds can be structured in a way that would allow all or a portion of this residual amount to be paid shortly after the state payment. Participants will be notified of the timing and amount of payment as soon as possible.

The Annual Business Luncheon enabled delegates to vote on two public policy statements. One, on the continuation of Corporate Governance – 2005 (CORBA) and the second addressing Federal Tax Policy and Perseverance of the Tax-Exempt Status of Municipal Bonds 2005 (DEBT). The conference also recognized the transfer of presidential powers from out-going President Nancy L. Zielke, University of Missouri-Kansas City incoming GFOA President, Carla E. Sledge of Wayne County, Michigan.

GFOA's 100th Annual Conference will be held May 7-10, 2006 in Montreal, Canada. DL

#### SELECTED REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Under existing law (California Government Code Section 8855(k)). "The issuer of any proposed new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation incorporated for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 30 days prior to the sale of any debt issue at public or private sale, give written notice of the proposed sale to the Commission, by mail. postage prepaid."

Under California Government Code Section 8855(I), "The issuer of any new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 45 days after the signing of the bond purchase contract in a negotiated or private financing, or after the acceptance of a bid in a competitive offering, submit a report of final sale to the commission by mail, postage prepaid, or by any other method approved by the commission. A copy of the official statement for the issue shall accompany the report of final sale. The Commission may require information to be submitted in the report of final sale that is considered appropriate."

Under California Government Code Section 53583(c)(2)(B) if a "local agency determines to sell the (refunding) bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis, the local agency shall send a written statement, within two weeks after the bonds are sold, to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission explaining the reasons why the local agency determined to sell the bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis instead of at public sale."
