CDIAC TO RELEASE 2008 LOCAL AGENCY INVESTMENT GUIDELINES

CDIAC is pleased to announce the forthcoming publication of its 2008 Local Agency Investment Guidelines (the "Guidelines"). The Guidelines, organized in a question and answer format that includes minimum legal requirements and consensus recommendations, is an interpretive document designed to aid local officials and other interested parties in their efforts to implement California local agency investment statutes. It provides practical advice relative to today's public fund investing environment. The latest version of the Guidelines contains the 2007 consensus recommendations, updates for 2008 statutory changes, and a redesigned layout with tabbed sections for easier reference.

Background. The *Guidelines* was originally developed in 1996 when CDIAC assembled a task force to provide practical advice regarding interpreting the numerous statutory changes that were enacted in the aftermath of the 1994 Orange County investment pool bankruptcy. Since 1996, CDIAC annually updated the *Guidelines* for statutory changes, but did not revise the consensus recommendations. In recognition of the maturation of public fund investing in California, in December 2006, CDIAC convened another working group to revise and update the consensus recommendations found in the *Guidelines*.

The revised Guidelines addresses issues such as:

- Allowable investment instruments Listings of permissible investments with their limitations and restrictions, displayed in a reference-chart format.
- Agency investment policy Advice on the timing and extent of the review of the investment policy and recommendations for rendering it to the local agency's legislative body.
- Investment portfolio reporting The purpose of cash flow analyses and best practices for reporting the value of securities.

- Safekeeping arrangements Appropriate provisions for agreements with a third-party entity holding an agency's securities.
- Treasury oversight committees Roles and responsi bilities of an oversight committee with respect to an agency's compliance with provisions of Government Code, and approaches to establishing an oversight committee.
- The *Guidelines* also includes information on recent developments and practices in public fund investment management. Topics include:
- Duration as a market interest-rate risk indicator.
- Fiduciary responsibility of investment management firms.
- Evaluating and monitoring medium-term notes, particularly investments in corporate securities, in an ever-changing global environment.

Statutory Changes Effective in 2008. One change that affects allowable local government investment instruments was enacted in 2007. AB 1745 modified Government Code Section 53601 to authorize, among other things, local agencies to invest excess funds in notes and bonds issued by any of the 50 state governments of the U.S.

IN-BOX A Synopsis of Current Events in Public Finance

California's Pooled Investment Fund Has No Investments in Structured Investment Vehicles

In a recent Los Angeles Times article, the State Treasurer's Office said that the Pooled Money Investment Account (PMIA) including the Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF) hold no structured investment vehicles (SIVs) or Collateralized Debt Obligations (CDOs) and has only a minimal amount of asset-backed commerical paper tied to sub-prime loans.¹ This announcement comes at a time when SIVs and CDOs backed by sub-prime mortgages have garnered increased scrutiny with respect to the security of their repayment sources. The Treasurer's Office is providing information to assure investors of the state's prudent investment practices in light of recent events experienced by the State of Florida's local agency investment pool.²

A statement currently posted on the PMIA's website publicizes that PMIA does not invest in SIVs or CDOs, the two types of securities that have been attributed to the recent troubles experienced by the State of Florida's pooled fund. While the fund does own \$3.7 billion of asset-backed commerical paper, only \$4.2 million is tied to sub-prime loans.³ The Treasurer's Office has received inquiries from municipalities on the funds' investments, but to date none of the over 2,620 participating municipalities have withdrawn from the fund. As of the end of September 2007, PMIA had an ending portfolio of \$61.20 billion and LAIF had an ending balance of \$19.2 billion.⁴

The State Treasurer invests taxpayers' money to manage the state's cash flow through the PMIA, which includes LAIF, a pooled investment program that enables local governments to place money in a major investment pool managed by the state to meet their investment needs. The State Sells Bond Issue Without Credit Enhancement

The State of California sold \$1 billion in tax-exempt, general obligations bonds to fund infrastructure projects throughout the state, including school construction and street and road improvements. The 30-year bonds have a yield of 4.86 percent.

While not the largest of the state's recent issues, this deal has garnered attention because it was sold without bond insurance. Recent reports that bond insurers are under review by the credit rating agencies to determine their exposure to subprime mortgage backed debt has led issuers to speculate about the value of purchasing bond insurance at this time. To accommodate the uninsured sale, the state switched its method of sale from competitive to negotiated.

This bond issue was another success for the Treasurer's effort to attract more retail investors to the state's bonds. Individual investors purchased approximately \$350 million (35 percent) of the bonds during the three-day retail order period, including all the bonds maturing in 2023, 2027, and 2033.

UCLA Anderson Forecast: No Recession for State

According to the latest Univerity of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) Anderson Forecast (Forecast), California's economic growth will continue to be slow, but the state will avoid a recession during the coming year. In its fourth quarterly report of 2007, the Forecast maintained that the "weakness in the vast real estate sector will be the central component of a sluggish economy, but there will not be enough job loss to trigger a state-wide recession."⁵

The Forecast maintains that the state's economy is expected to grow next year because it takes weakness in two major sectors to cause a recession and no other area seems likely to turn down sharply to trigger a recession. Specifically, the Forecast anticipates that the state's unemployment will peak at 6.1 percent in late 2008, with non-farm job growth remaining below 1 percent through the end of the year. According to the Forecast, real growth in the 1-2 percent range is expected for both the Gross State Product and Personal Income for 2008.

The national economy also is not technically in a recession, according to the Forecast, nor does the Forecast anticipate a recession during the period. While the national economy also has been affected by the real estate sector as well as higher oil prices and a troubling rate of consumer debt, the Forecast does not expect enough job losses to trigger an actual recession.

The UCLA Anderson Forecast provides oft-cited economic forecasts for the U.S., California, Los Angeles County, Orange County and other regional economies based upon numerical projections for major economic indicators, such as inflation, interest rates, job growth and gross domestic product growth. S&P Report: Most States Ready to Handle New OPEB Standards

Standard & Poor's recently released a report indicating that most states appear ready to handle the new accounting and reporting standards for other post-employment benefit (OPEB) liabilities as required by Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Statement 45. In the report, *U.S. States Are Quantifying OPEB Liabilities and Developing Funding Strategies As the GASB Deadline Nears*, S&P notes that 40 states have already completed an actuarial valuation of their respective OPEB liabilities. Cumulatively these states have OPEB liabilities totaling nearly \$400 billion, with individual liabilities varying from \$52 million for North Dakota to \$58.1 billion for New Jersey.

The report indicates that with or without pre-funding OPEB liabilities, state governments can continue meeting ongoing OPEB cost requirements with no adverse effect on near-term credit quality. However, the increasing costs that governments face for health care and the growing retiree population could strain budgets and balance sheets over the long term. While the GASB standards do not require municipalities to present plans to fund the liabilities, the report found that many states were already in the process of developing strategies to manage their long-term funding requirements. The report notes that states are adopting a variety of tactics, including forming task forces or commissions to review current funding patterns and issue recommendations as well as establishing trust funds to fund longer-term OPEB needs.

The report includes a description of each of the fifty states' OPEB liability assessments (if available) and the proposed funding strategies. All states and municipalities are expected to comply with GASB 45 by the end of 2009. The report is available on-line from Standard & Poor's for a fee.

Under existing law (California Government Code Section 8855(k)), "The issuer of any proposed new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation incorporated for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 30 days prior to the sale of any debt issue at public or private sale, give written notice of the proposed sale to the Commission, by mail, postage prepaid."

Under California Government Code Section 8855(I), "The issuer of any new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 45 days after the signing of the bond purchase contract in a negotiated or private financing, or after the acceptance of a bid in a competitive offering, submit a report of final sale to the commission by mail, postage prepaid, or by any other method approved by the commission. A copy of the official statement for the issue shall accompany the report of final sale. The Commission may require information to be submitted in the report of final sale that is considered appropriate."

Under California Government Code Section 53583(c)(2)(B) if a "local agency determines to sell the (refunding) bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis, the local agency shall send a written statement, within two weeks after the bonds are sold, to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission explaining the reasons why the local agency determined to sell the bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis instead of at public sale."
