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GOVERNOR RELEASES REVISION TO PROPOSED BUDGET

On May 14, the Governor released his May Revision, an update of revenue projections, policy proposals, and estimated expenditures for both the current and upcoming fiscal years. The May Revision replaces estimates found in the Governor's Budget Proposal that was submitted to the Legislature on January 10, 2008.

Revenue Projections

General Fund revenues are expected to be \$103 billion for fiscal year 2008-09, an increase of \$83 million compared to the Governor's Budget Proposal (see Figure 1). These revenues include: \$11.7 billion in revenue "solutions" to close the budget gap, \$1.9 billion from a change in accrual accounting, \$5.1 billion of lottery proceeds from a proposed fund transfer, and \$1.4 billion in other initiatives.

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Policy Proposals

The Governor's Budget Proposal estimated a budget gap of \$14.5 billion. Since January 10, the Governor estimates that the deficit has grown by \$9.8 billion, to a total of \$24.3 billion. Part of this deficit was addressed by a Special Session of the Legislature, bringing the total down to \$17.2 billion. The May Revision policy proposals include the following:

Fully funding the Proposition 98 guarantee and increase total funding for education. Restore \$1.8 bil-

lion General Fund thereby increasing Proposition 98 in 2008-09 to the minimum Proposition 98 Guarantee level.

- Savings of \$300 million from the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation budget.
- Funding to keep all state parks open while increasing fees where feasible to offset General Fund costs.
- Reducing health and human services program funding by \$627 million.
- Creating a Revenue Stabilization Fund (RSF), a new reserve fund, to be used for moderating

A Synopsis of Current Events in Public Finance

UBS to Close Public Finance Department

UBS AG announced that it will sell or close its U.S. municipal securities business. The Swiss bank is restructuring its investment banking operations, reducing its operations in the business areas with the most risk. The firm is actively seeking a buyer for its municipal business, which it will close if no buyer is found. As part of the restructuring, UBS AG will move part of the institutional municipal securities group into its wealth management division.

UBS AG entered the U.S. municipal market with the acquisition of PaineWebber, Inc. in 2000. Since that time, UBS AG was consistently ranked as one of the top tax-exempt underwriting firms. Recent turmoil in the municipal market has resulted in greater concentration of the municipal bond underwriting business with the recent acquisition of Bear Stearns by JPMorgan coupled with UBS's imminent departure from the municipal business.

Second Lawsuit to Stop Prison Bond Sale

Another lawsuit challenging the State's prison bond financing plan was filed in Sacramento Superior Court. Californians United for a Responsible Budget (CURB), an advocacy group that wants to reduce the state's prison population, filed the lawsuit challenging Assembly Bill 900 (Solorio), the Public Safety and Offender Rehabilitation Services Act of 2007, which authorizes approximately \$7.9 billion in lease-revenue bonds to fund construction that will add approximately 40,000 state prison beds and 13,000 county jail beds for various correctional and rehabilitation facilities.¹

While the State has a long history of using lease-revenue financing to fund state projects, including the construction of 11 state prison facilities, CURB's lawsuit challenges several aspects of the approved prison financing plan. Principally, CURB questions the constitutionality of financing prison construction with lease-revenue bonds, which do not require voter approval. In addition, CURB asserts that lease-revenue financing inefficiently uses government resources because they are more expensive than general obligation bonds. The State's interim \$3.5 billion financing plan that was recently approved by the State Public Works Board is also being challenged by CURB because it was not approved by voters and is considered "debt" by the group. A hearing date has not been set.

In October 2007, a trial court judge ruled against Taxpayers for Improving Public Safety (TiPS), which filed a similar lawsuit challenging the prison financing last year. The TiPS lawsuit is currently under appeal.

MSRB Files Rule Changes for NIIDS Test

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (MSRB) filed a proposed rule change with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) that would amend Rule G-34, *CUSIP Numbers and New Issue Requirements*, to require underwriters to register and conduct tests with the Depository Trust and Clearing Corporation's (DTCC) New Issue Information Dissemination System (NIIDS) before September 15, 2008.² MSRB's proposed changes will help ensure that dealers are prepared for the implementation of NIIDS. Beginning September 30, 2008, all dealers of municipal securities with maturities of nine months or greater will be required to use NIIDS, a centralized system for collecting and communicating new issue securities information.

NIIDS was designed to improve the timeliness and accuracy of information delivered from new bond issuances. With NIIDS, underwriters send new issue information electronically to DTCC that is then uniformly disseminated electronically on a near real-time basis to market participants so they can confirm, clear and report trades in a timely and accurate manner. According to DTCC, plans call for NIIDS to be expanded to automate the collection and distribution of information on corporate bonds, asset-backed securities and other fixed-income securities.

California's Stem Cell Research Grant Awards

The board of the California Institute for Regenerative Medicine (CIRM), voted to award \$271 million in grant funding to 12 California institutions to build stem cell research facilities throughout the state. According to the CIRM Press Release, the twelve grant recipients, including eight University of California campuses, have committed additional funds totaling \$1.1 billion to leverage the bond funded grant awards.³

Established in 2004 with the passage of Proposition 71, the California Stem Cell Research and Cures Act provided \$3 billion in bond funding for stem cell research at California universities and research institutions. CIRM makes grants and provide loans for stem cell research, research facilities, and other vital research opportunities. To date, the CIRM governing board has approved 168 research and facility grants to 22 California non-profit and academic institutions totaling more than \$530 million. LOCAL AGENCIES MUST REPORT ON DEFAULTS AND DRAWS ON RESERVE

The California Government Code requires issuers to report to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) within ten days of defaults or draws on reserve funds for Marks-Roos Bond Pooling Act and Mello-Roos Community Facilities District bonds.

Specifically, for Mello-Roos bonds, Government Code Section 53359.5(c) requires authorities to notify CDIAC within ten days of any:

- failure to pay principal and interest on any scheduled payment date, or
- withdrawal from a reserve fund to pay principal and interest on the bonds that reduces the reserve fund to less than the reserve required.

This section pertains to any Mello-Roos bond, regardless of when sold.

For Marks-Roos bonds, Government Code Section 6599.1(c) requires authorities to notify CDIAC within ten days of any:

- failure to pay principal and interest on any scheduled payment date, or
- withdrawal from a reserve fund to pay principal and interest on the bonds issued by the authority or any bonds acquired by the authority.

For withdrawals from the reserve fund to pay principal and interest, CDIAC requires Marks-Roos authorities to report only if the reserve fund is reduced to less than the reserve required. This section pertains to any Marks-Roos bonds, regardless of when sold.

The law requires issuers to submit specific information regarding their issuance(s) (issuers should refer to the Government Code Sections provided above for details). CDIAC has developed forms for issuers to complete that provide this information. Issuers then must submit these forms either by mail or via the Internet. Notifications sent by mail must use the *Draw on Reserves/Default Form for Mello-Roos/Marks-Roos Issue*, available on CDIAC's website, www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac/reporting_mail.asp, and should be mailed to the following address:

year-to-year changes in General Fund expenditures. The Governor proposes to capitalize this fund in 2008-09 with \$5.1 billion, derived from securitizing the Lottery. The Governor proposes that immediately after depositing the Lottery proceeds in the RSF, the Legislature transfer the \$5.1 billion to the General Fund to close the budget gap.

- Imposing a temporary one-cent sales tax increase, to remain in effect until the RSF balance reaches 15 percent of General Fund tax revenues, or until June 30, 2011, whichever is first.
- Issuing an Executive Order to establish a bipartisan commission of legislative and gubernatorial appointees to modernize the State's tax laws.
- Providing operational flexibility to the California Lottery and securitize future revenues similar to the way the Tobacco Securitization Bonds work. It is estimated that this will yield \$5.1 billion in revenue in 2008-09.

Estimated Expenditures

The May Revision includes only one budget code item exclusively identified as "Local Government Financing." This budget item, included under the General Government category, shows that local assistance funding would decrease by \$29.4 million from the Governor's Budget Proposal. In addition to the Local Government Financing budget item found in the General

Government program area, funding for local government is spread throughout the Budget in various budget items under the appropriation entitled "Local Assistance." Below are some local assistance programs mentioned in the May Revision:

- \$1.2 billion (\$315.7 General Fund) increase to the Medi-Cal program. This increase reflects the following adjustments:
 - o \$173.1 million increase due to an erosion of savings from various proposed budget balancing reductions.
 - \$169.8 million increase to fund rate adjustments for Medi-Cal managed health care plans.
 - o \$102.7 increase due to the new interim rate payment process for Designated Public Hospitals.
 - o \$86.7 million decrease by limiting benefits for newlyqualified immigrants and immigrants who permanently reside under the color of law.
- \$841.1 million increase for restoring school district revenue limits.
- \$780 million increase in workload adjustments for school district revenue limits.
- \$234.1 million increase for special education programs.
- \$376 million reduction in the CalWORKs Temporary

KENTUCKY v. DAVIS VERDICT

The U.S. Supreme Court Overturns Kentucky Court of Appeals Decision

In a 7-2 decision, the U.S. Supreme Court has ruled that Kentucky and 41 other states can continue taxing interest on out-of-state municipal bonds while exempting interest on their own bonds without violating the U.S. Constitution. In the case of the Department of Revenue of the Commonwealth of Kentucky v. Davis (Docket # No. 06-666), the Court was asked to determine whether the practice of the State of Kentucky in taxing residents interest income on municipal bonds issued by other states, but not interest income on bonds issued by the State and its subdivisions, is prohibited by the Commerce Clause of the U. S. Constitution. The Justices concluded that Kentucky's differential tax practices on bonds does not discriminate against interstate commerce, but rather promotes the financing of essential governmental services. This decision essentially maintains the status quo in the municipal market.

Background

George W. and Catherine V. Davis sued the Commonwealth of Kentucky in 2003 for trying to tax the interest from their out-of-state bond holdings. Although the two initially lost in trial court, the Kentucky Court of Appeals ruled in their favor after finding that the State's taxation system is "facially unconstitutional" because it affords more favorable taxation treatment to in-state bonds than to "extraterritorially" issued debt. The Kentucky Supreme Court refused to hear the case to allow it to proceed to the U.S. Supreme Court. Oral arguments were heard November 2007.

Majority Opinion

In the majority opinion, written by Justice David Souter, the justices concluded that "Kentucky's tax exemption favors a traditional government function without any differential treatment favoring local entities over substantially similar out-of-state interests."1 Chief Justice Roberts and Justices Antonin Scalia, Clarence Thomas, John Paul Stevens, Ruth Bader Ginsburg and Stephen Breyer joined Souter in the majority ruling. In forming their opinion, the justices took into account the market ramifications of banishing the widely practiced tax exemption for in-state bonds. Particularly pressing to Souter was the potential fall out from upholding the lower court decision, which would likely result in the disappearance of the vast majority of single-state mutual funds that often hold bonds of "weaker" municipal issuers. The court also found that the states' desire to keep in place the preferential practices, despite the fact that they often lose more in tax revenue than they save in interest expenses, shows that these practices were not intended to gain a competitive advantage. Forty-nine states, including California filed friend-of-the-court briefs in support of Kentucky, a factor that contributed to the court's ruling. In the majority opinion Souter wrote:

"...nearly every taxing state believes its public interests are served by the same tax-and-exemption feature, which is supported in this court by every one of the states (with or without an income tax) despite the ranges of relative wealth and tax rates among them. These facts suggest that no state perceives any local advantage or disadvantage beyond the permissible ones open to a government and to those who deal with it when that government itself enters the market."²

The justices also noted that about two-thirds of capital expenditures by state and local governments are financed with municipal bond proceeds. "Bonds place the cost of a project on the citizens who benefit from it over the years, and they allow for public work beyond what current revenues would support," Souter wrote.³

Dissent Opinion

Dissenting from the majority opinion were Justices Anthony Kennedy and Samuel Alito. In their dissent, they argued that the majority's conclusion that Kentucky could use taxes to prefer its own bonds as part of its "cardinal civic responsibilities" is overly broad. In addition, they argued that the basis for the majority opinion is wrong because the differential tax practices on bonds do not affect Kentucky, but rather the holders and traders of its bonds, adding that if the court was afraid of disrupting the market because interstate discrimination has been entrenched in most states for nearly a century, it should have stated that as the basis for its decision. Kennedy, who authored the dissenting opinion, believes the court could have achieved the same goal without setting a dangerous precedent that makes it easier for other states to engage in economic protectionism.

While the ruling upheld the market status quo in its decision, the court left the door open to possible future challenges focusing on private-activity or conduit bonds issued by governmental entities for private borrowers.

Market Reaction

The decision was not a surprise for most market participants. General consensus among market participants was that the *Kentucky* ruling would be aligned with the courts earlier decision in the case of *United Haulers* v. *Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Management Authority* (2007), which also cited a violation of the dormant commerce clause. In the *United Haulers* decision the court expressed a willingness to allow governments to exhibit a preference for themselves over out-of-state private competitors if it serves a public good.

CALIFORNIA DEBT AND INVESTMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION

REPORTING FEE SCHEDULE
Date of Adoption: June 10, 2008
EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008

Pursuant to Section 8856 of the California Government Code, the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) adopted the following two-phased fee schedule effective upon adoption.

- 1. Issues Purchased by Agencies of the Federal Government: No fee shall be charged on any issue purchased by an agency of the Federal Government.
- 2. Issues of Less Than \$1,000,000: No fee shall be charged to the lead underwriter or purchaser of any public debt issue which has a par value amount less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000), regardless of the term of the issue.
- 3. Issues with Short-Term Maturities: Notwithstanding Sections 1 and 2 above, the lead underwriter or purchaser of any public debt issue which has a maturity of eighteen (18) months or less, including those issues sold in a pooled financing (e.g., a TRANs pool), shall be required to pay a fee to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission in accordance with the following schedule:
 - A. For such issues sold on July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010, the fee will be equal to one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150).
 - B. For such issues sold on or after July 1, 2010, the fee will be equal to two hundred dollars (\$200).
- 4. Issues with Long-Term Maturities: Notwithstanding Sections 1, 2, and 3 above, the lead underwriter or purchaser of any public debt issue which has a final maturity greater than eighteen (18) months shall be required to pay a fee to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission in accordance with the following fee schedule:
 - A. For such issues sold on July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010, the fee will be equal to 1.5 basis points (0.00015) not to exceed three thousand dollars (\$3,000).
 - B. For such issues sold on or after July 1, 2010, the fee will be equal to 2.0 basis points (.0002) not to exceed four thousand dollars (\$4,000).
- **5. Marks-Roos Financing Authority Issues:** One fee will be assessed for Marks-Roos Financing Authority bond issues where the bond sales occur simultaneously (i.e., reports filed with the Commission are received on the same date, financings are sold on the same date, and with the same financing team).
- 6. All Proposed and Final Sales to be Reported to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission: Nothing in this fee schedule shall relieve an issuer from giving written notice of a proposed debt issue no later than 30 days prior to the proposed sale, or to give final sale information within 45 days of the sale, to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission as required by Sections 8855(k) and (l) of the California Government Code.

Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Block Grant program to balance higher caseloads and per case costs, and as a result of an erosion of savings assumed in the Governor's Budget Proposal. These reductions will be made in the following areas: cost of living adjustments, grants, self-sufficiency reviews, county pay-for-performance incentives, performance and fraud incentives, reimbursement rates, and reserves.

• \$110.7 million decrease to the In-Home Supportive Services program.

\$80 million decrease for California Student Aid
 Commission local assistance funding. This money
 was included in the Governor's Budget Proposal as a
 placeholder in the event that the University of California
 and California State Universities raised fees further and
 has been deleted from the May Revision.
