2009 TAX AND REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES

Total Issuances

Tax and revenue anticipation notes (TRANs) are short-term notes primarily used as an interim financing tool to fund an issuer's temporary cash flow deficit. Notes are generally issued at the beginning of a fiscal year, maturing in 15 months or less, in anticipation of receiving tax receipts and revenues at a future date. Revenues from property tax payments and other general fund revenues of a single fiscal year are commonly designated as the source of repayment for TRANs. This article provides a brief summary of TRAN issuances for the first half of 2009.

TRANs are issued individually or through a pooled financing structure. Public agencies will use the pooled financing method to reduce the administrative and issuance costs involved in borrowing money, as well as to reap the benefits of improved market access and lower interest rates achieved through economies of scale.

For 2009, issuers reported 309 proposed and sold TRAN issues (\$8.1 bil-

lion), significantly more than the 121 proposed and sold issues reported during this same period last year. Of this amount, pool issuers reported 261 TRAN issues (\$2.2 billion). Seven different pools reported TRAN issues - two more than issuers reported in 2008. Another 48 TRAN issues (\$5.9 billion) were proposed or sold by individual issuers (see Figure 1 below).

Figure 2 below displays TRAN issuances over the past ten years, categorized by both total volume in millions of dollars and the number of issuances per year. From 1999 to 2005, issuance ranged between \$5.7 billion and \$6.1 billion; even as, the number of issues steadily decreased from 703 in 1999 to 485 in 2004.


The trend for the number of TRAN issues continued through 2008. In 2006, issuance decreased to 138, 59.5 percent less than the 341 issues in the previous year.

Volume remained steady from 2006 to 2008, but significantly increased the first six months in 2009. In fact, compared to 2008, the increase in volume of 52.5 percent (from \$5.3 billion to \$8.1 billion) in 2009 was not as extraordinary as the increase in the number of issues (117.6 percent, from 142 to 309).

Figure 3 below compares the last six years of TRAN financings by pools and individual issuers.

A Synopsis of Current Events in Public Finance

State-UC Private Placement Transaction

The State Treasurer's Office and University of California (UC) completed a \$199.9 million bond deal to fund building projects and expand "telemedidne" services at eight UC campuses. UC bought the general obligation bonds in a "private placement" transaction, in which the bonds were offered only to UC.¹ The Treasurer's Office has used private placements with public entities to help keep funds flowing to infrastructure projects while the state coped with ongoing fiscal difficulties. The bonds have an interest rate of 3.183 percent and have a mandatory tender in November 2012.

Bond proceeds will finance voter-approved general obligation bond projects at the following eight UC campuses: Los Angeles, Irvine, Riverside, San Diego, Davis, San Francisco, Santa Barbara and Santa Cruz. The funds will primarily be used for "telemedidne" projects, improving the ability of UC medical experts to consult with others across the country. Each campus will have one to three renovation and/or manufacturing requests, whether it is the construction of a new building, the expansion of a facility, or updating laboratory or visual art equipment. UCSC will receive the largest sum with \$65.4 million for a new five-story biomedical sciences facility and new digital arts facility.

Including the latest transaction, the state has placed \$737 million of GO bonds since February with various public entities, including the Bay Area Toll Authority, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority, the San Bernardino Associated Governments, Solano County, and the UC system.

State to Stop Issuing IOUs

September 4th will be the last day the State Contoller will issue registered warrants (IOUs) to cover the state's cash deficit. The decision to stop issuing IOUs is based on analysis of projections from the recently approved fiscal year 2009-10 state budget. The Controller considered additional revenue projections and cash pressures, such as potential litigation, to determine when the state will have sufficient funds to meet all of its payment obligations, including the redemption of outstanding IOUs.

Interim revenue anticipation notes (RANs) totalling \$1.5 billion will be issued by the Treasuer's Office by August 28 to provide the cash resources to redeem the outstanding

IOUs. In addition, the Treasurer's Office anticipates issuing approximately \$10.5 billion of RANs in mid-September to pay off the interim notes and meet the state's cash needs for FY 2009-10.

At an emergency meeting of the Pooled Money Investment Board (PMIB) on August 21, the board approved an updated redemption date of September 4th. Since July 2nd, the state has issued 327,000 IOUs totaling \$1.95 billion to pay for state operations and expenses not legally or constitutionally protected.

California's Liabilities

In a memo to Assembly Member Arambula, the Legislative Analyst's Office (LAO) identified the state's key liabilities. Specifically the LAO was requested by Arambula to identify debt, deferred payments, and other liabilities that impact the state's financial health in the future. The LAO identified over \$200 billion of short-term, longer-term, and retirement-related liabilities that the state needs to account for in future years.

The LAO classified the state's liabilities into three categories:

- Budget-Related Liabilities. These liabilities consist of actions taken by the state that have resulted in future budgetary obligations; including Proposition 98 deferrals, employee pay and benefit deferrals, and special fund budgetary loan repayments and total approximately \$35 billion.
- Infrastructure-Related Liabilities. These liabilities consist mostly of state's bonded indebtedness in the form of general obligation (GO) and lease-revenue bond (LRB) debt and total approximately \$69 billion.
- Retirement-Related Liabilities. These liabilities include unfunded actuarially accrued liabilities for pensions and retiree health benefits and exceed \$100 billion.

FROM PASSAGE TO IMPLEMENTATION: THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009

Responding to nationwide concerns about the recession, Congress and President Obama approved a financial package with ambitious goals to spur economic recovery by providing assistance to public agencies for economic development, education, infrastructure, transportation, and renewable energy. Of particular interest to public agencies are the municipal market changes and new municipal bond programs created by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (The Recovery Act) to aid public agencies in funding projects to aid economic recovery. The numerous municipal bond initiatives authorized under the Recovery Act, while temporary, reflect the most changes to the municipal bond market since the 1986 tax overhaul bill.

Due to the temporary nature of the municipal market changes authorized by the Recovery Act, the

California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) partnered with the California Infrastructure and Economic Development Bank (I-Bank) to host, "The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Financing Opportunities for California's Public Agencies," a seminar that provided timely information about the low-cost financing opportunities available to California's public agencies resulting from Recovery Act. The seminar featured panels that discussed general changes to the public finance market, tax credit bond programs, and new bond programs authorized by the Recovery Act. Recovery Act Authorization

Now, almost nine months since the President signed the Recovery Act into law, how are the Recovery Act programs and changes being used by public agencies? The accompanying chart reflects the Recovery Act related bond activity by California issuers since February 2009. As reflected in the chart. Build America Bonds (BABs) have been the most widely used Recovery Act program by California issuers, with 18 issues totaling approximately \$7.8 billion. Use of the Qualified School Construction Bonds (QSCBs) program has been limited to just one issuer, the San Diego Unified School District for \$38.8 million.

CDIAC, in partnership with The Bond Buyer, is hosting, "Will the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Resuscitate the Economy?" as a pre-conference seminar to complement the Bond Buyer's 19th Annual California Public Finance Conference. This seminar will provide additional insight on which public agencies have issued under the new Recovery Act authorizations as well as how they are using the proceeds. Speakers will reflect on the current economic condition of California and assess how the state is combating the recession.

THE LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNOR'S BUDGET DANCE HAS TWO ACTS IN 2009

The Legislature and Governor completed their 2009 budget negotiations in two parts: They passed the 2009 Budget Act in February and then amended it in July to re-balance the General Fund. Budget commentary, leaning on metaphor to describe the complex, sometimes refers to budget negotiations as a "dance." In 2009, the dance had two acts.

Taken together, the dance attempted to address a two-year \$60 billion General Fund budget gap. According to the Department of Finance, the budget problem resulted from a "planned" deficit from last year of \$1.9 billion, a \$47.3 billion revenue shortfall from the revenue "baseline" and a \$10.8 billion increase in "workload" spending. See Figure 1. Finance says that the revenue reduction "is due almost entirely to the economic recession."

In February's Act 1, the Legislature and Governor negotiated solutions for \$35.8 billion of the problem. The balance, \$24.2 billion, they solved in July's Act 2.


Finance characterizes most of the solutions as "expenditure reductions." The Legislature and Governor adopted cuts to solve about \$31.0 billion (51.7 percent) of the problem. Tax solutions contributed \$12.5 billion (20.8 percent), while \$8.0 billion (13.3 percent) came from federal stimulus funds and about \$8.4 billion (14.0 percent) in other solutions. See Figure 2.

Local Contributions. The Legislative Analyst identifies ways in which local governments contributed to the solutions in four main areas:

(1) The state will borrow \$1.9 billion from local governments for up to three years and repay them with interest. Budget-trailer legislation will facilitate local governments' ability to borrow against the repayment stream. Some local officials question the state's authority to require the loan consistent with the provisions of Proposition 1A (2006).

- (2) The budget totals assume, and trailer legislation requires, redevelopment agencies (RDA) to shift \$1.7 billion in 2009-10 and \$.4 billion in 2010-11. These shifts reduce RDA revenues and provide state General Fund relief. Most commentators expect a legal challenge to this \$2.1 billion shift.
- (3) The budget suspends several state-imposed local mandates, for a General Fund savings of about \$66 million.
- (4) The Governor virtually eliminated funding for Williamson Act reimbursements by vetoing General Fund subventions for preserving agricultural lands and open space.

MELLO-ROOS AND MARK-ROOS ISSUERS TAKE NOTE:

Annual Mello-Roos Reports Due by October 30th

Has your Mello-Roos district sold bonds after January 1, 1993? If so, state law requires your district to file a yearly fiscal status report with the commission before the end of next month. The district must report bondfund balances, delinquencies, and draws-on-reserve. Districts must also report assessed values for properties within the district.

Districts may file electronically or by mail. The electronic report can be found on the commission's website, **www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac/reporting.asp**. To file electronically, filers will need their CDIAC Number and password. This information is unique to each filing and must be used for all annual reporting. If you need your CDIAC Number and password, please contact the CDIAC data unit at (916) 653-3269.

To file by mail, please use the PDF forms located on the website, downloaded from www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac/reporting_mail.asp.

Mark-Roos Bond Pools Must Report Yearly Fiscal Status

Participants and districts issuing debt through a Marks-Roos bond pool must report specified activity to the commission by October 30, 2009. The report requirement applies to any debt issued after January 1, 1996. Each district and each participant must report amounts deposited in reserves, construction funds and capitalized-interest funds. Statute also

requires the districts and participants to report draws-on-reserves, delinquency data and foreclosure information.

The filings, known as yearly fiscal status (YFS) reports, may be made by mail or electronically. To file by mail, use the PDF forms located on the website, downloaded from www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac/reporting_mail.asp.

The electronic report can be found on the commission's website, **www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac/reporting.asp**. To file electronically, filers will need their CDIAC Number and password. This information is unique to each filing and must be used for all annual reporting.

Participants and districts can identify their CDIAC Number and password, by contacting the commission's data unit at (916) 653-3269.

Marks-Roos and Mello-Roos Districts To Report on Occurrences of Draws on Reserve and Defaults

All Marks-Roos bond pooling districts and Mello-Roos community facility districts (CFDs) must report their draws-on-reserve and defaults to the commission. This statutory requirement, enacted long before the subprime mortgage bubble burst and the securitization market seized, applies to all Marks-Roos authorities and participants. It applies also to all issuers of Mello-Roos bonds. Authorities, participants and issuers must report any occurrence of a non-payment of principal and interest (default) or use of reserve funds (draw-on-reserve) to make principal and interest payments. They must report the date and amount of the occurrence within ten days of the event. Reports may be made electronically or by mail. The latest edition of the *California Public Fund Investment Primer* (*Investment Primer*) will be published by the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) later this fall. The *Investment Primer* is a resource intended to help public agencies understand and evaluate investments options. It describes commonly used public investment concepts, terms, and instruments.

The *Investment Primer* addresses the roles and responsibilities of participants involved in public-fund management, the types of investments available, investment-portfolio development, administration, operation, and applicable legal and ethical issues. Chapters of the *Investment Primer* are written to promote quick access to information regarding public fund investment, by particular topic. Specifically:

Chapter 1: Public Fund Investment Roles and Responsibilities describes the roles and responsibilities of participants typically involved in public fund management, including investment officials, legislative bodies, oversight committees, investment/financial advisers, brokers/dealers, and trustees/custodial banks.

Chapter 2: Investment Concepts, Terminology, and Instruments defines and describes typical investment concepts and terms, and types of individual instruments available for public fund investment (including their characteristics, safety, liquidity and yield).

Chapter 3: Investment Portfolio Development and Management discusses investment policies, investment portfolio reporting, cashflow forecasting for both operating and capital funds, credit risk evaluation, structuring a portfolio, and evaluating a portfolio.

Chapter 4: Other (Non-Surplus) Fund Investment describes issues relating to the investment of tax-exempt bond proceeds and pension funds.

Chapter 5: Liability and Ethical Issues describes liability issues for those responsible for public fund investment and ethical issues affecting public fund investment.

The *Investment Primer* also provides practical examples, such as sample contracts and checklists.

As with the first edition of the *Investment Primer*, this document would not be the reliable resource of information that it is with-

SELECTED REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Under existing law (California Government Code Section 8855(k)), "The issuer of any proposed new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation incorporated for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 30 days prior to the sale of any debt issue at public or private sale, give written notice of the proposed sale to the Commission, by mail, postage prepaid."

Under California Government Code Section 8855(I), "The issuer of any new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 45 days after the signing of the bond purchase contract in a negotiated or private financing, or after the acceptance of a bid in a competitive offering, submit a report of final sale to the commission by mail, postage prepaid, or by any other method approved by the commission. A copy of the official statement for the issue shall accompany the report of final sale. The Commission may require information to be submitted in the report of final sale that is considered appropriate."

Under California Government Code Section 53583(c)(2)(B) if a "local agency determines to sell the (refunding) bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis, the local agency shall send a written statement, within two weeks after the bonds are sold, to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission explaining the reasons why the local agency determined to sell the bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis instead of at public sale."
