STATE DEBT SUPPORTED BY THE GENERAL FUND

State Debt to Keep Rising?



The state issued \$32 billion worth of new General Fund-backed debt during the first eleven months of 2009. In testimony before the Assembly Budget Committee on December 14, State Treasurer Bill Lockyer reported details of the debt issued by the state through the public capital markets. The Treasurer detailed the amount of general obligation (GO) debt issued relative to the amount authorized, the types of projects funded by state bond proceeds and the state's likely mediumterm debt service costs.

GENERAL OBLIGATION DEBT AC-COUNTS FOR OVER HALF. After accounting for refunds (about \$4.1 billion), the state issued \$36.1 billion in General Fund-backed debt from January 1, 2009. Of this amount, the Treasurer reported that he sold about \$19.7 billion in GO debt, accounting for about 56 percent of all General Fund debt sold in the public capital markets. About a quarter of the state's debt was associated with revenue anticipation notes (RANs). He also sold \$3.4 billion worth of economic recovery bonds (ERBs) and \$2.2 billion worth of State Public Works Board lease revenue bonds. Together, the ERB and works board debt accounted for about 15 percent of all General Fund-backed debt issued in the public capital markets. The state also sold \$1.9 billion worth of bonds to finance repaying local governments for the 2009-10 property tax shift. This debt, referred to as "Prop 1A" financing, accounted for about 5 percent of all state bond proceeds. Please see Figure 1 for a graphic representation of the state's new and refunded debt issued between January 1, 2009 and November 30, 2009.

The Treasurer also reported how the bond proceeds were allocated among major program areas. The state allocated nearly one-third of all GO debt proceeds to either repay loan advances or refund existing debt. It allocated about one-fifth of all proceeds for both transportation and education projects. In particular, K-12 school districts received about 13 percent of the proceeds while higher education institutions received about 9 percent. Natural resource projects received about 17 percent. The balance of

the bond proceeds, about 10 percent, went to housing, hospitals and stem-cell research. See Figure 2.

Of the GO debt authorizations that have not yet been sold, half of the authorization is for additional transportation projects, and about 20 percent each for natural resources and education. The balance, about 11 percent of unissued GO debt authorization would be available for all other projects, including housing and stem-cell research. See Figure 3.

In looking at the state's ability to accommodate this much debt, the Treasurer reported that if the state were to continue issuing all authorized debt plus the proposed water bond, the state's annual General Fund debt payments would rise from about \$6.1 bil-

A Synopsis of Current Events in Public Finance

LAO: CALIFORNIA'S FISCAL OUTLOOK - BUDGET DEFICITS

The Legislative Analyst's Office (LAO) released the latest projections for the state's fiscal outlook for fiscal years 2009-10 through 2014-15. Based on current funding requirements, the LAO projects a budget deficit of \$20.7 billion between now and the time the Legislature enacts a 2010-11 state budget plan – with General Fund expenditures exceeding revenues by approximately \$6.3 billion for the current fiscal year (2009-10) and by \$14.4 billion in 2010-11.1

The LAO's fiscal outlook report is prepared annually to inform the Legislature of the current conditions of the budget and provide a starting point for budget deliberations. Identified in this report are proposed revisions to address the current year deficit as well as recommendations for addressing the projected budget shortfalls in future years. The current year deficit is attributed to the following components included in the 2009-10 budget:

 Proposed spending reductions in the prison system and Medi-Cal programs not realized (several billion);

- No sale of the State Compensation Insurance Fund (SCIF) (\$1 billion);
- Court decision that prevents the General Fund from benefiting from use of transportation funds (\$800 million); and
- An increase in Proposition 98 minimum funding guarantee (\$1 billion).

Compounding the current budget deficit is the continued decline of tax revenues. The LAO estimates that General Fund revenues and transfers are \$88.1 billion, approximately \$1.5 billion less than what was assumed in the approved 2009-10 budget.

For 2010-11, the LAO projects a \$14.4 billion operating deficit. This shortfall is the result of one-time and temporary budget solutions used in crafting the 2009-10 budget; including the use of federal stimulus funds, shifting funds from local governments to the state, and one-time revenue accelerations that are not available for the 2010-11 budget. The LAO also cautions that current court cases threaten to increase the identified budget deficit.

¹ LAO's revenue and expenditure forecasts are based primarily on the requirements of current law, including constitutional provisions and statutory requirements. In other cases, the estimates incorporate effects of projected changes in caseloads, federal requirements, and other factors affecting program costs. In addition LAO projections do not include COLAs or inflation adjustments and it assumes that the state will prevail in all active litigation (including cases challenging shift of local redevelopment funds, state employee furloughs, and various health and social services reductions).

In future years (2011-12 through 2014-15), the LAO projects operating shortfalls of \$21.3 billion in 2011-12, \$23 billion in 2012-13, and \$18.4 billion in 2014-15. These shortfalls consist of the expiration of temporary tax increases, forecasted increased program spending, and the repayment of funds borrowed from local governments pursuant to Proposition 1A (2004). Revenues are projected to grow by at least 6.6 percent per year and outpace annual spending growth. During the later years of the forecast, spending growth in various health and social services programs is expected to moderate as the economy improves.

QUARTERLY ECONOMIC FORECAST

Providing both a state and national econoomic outlook, the UCLA Anderson Forecast released its quarterly economic report in December. According to UCLA economists, California's unemployment rate will peak at 12.7 percent this year and then start to subside in 2010, the forecast cautioned that recovery will be slow and painful, not growing at normal levels until mid 2011, and the unemployment rate will not slide below 10 percent until 2012. Economists forecast that employment will shrink by 4.3 percent in 2009 and contract an additional 0.7 percent in 2010 before beginning modest growth (1.7 percent) in 2011.

Economists from UCLA, Chapman University in Orange, Beacon Economics and Comerica Bank all agree the state's economy will continue to struggle for the foreseeable future with key industries such as housing and manufacturing not returning to pre-recession levels of employment for years.

USING YOUR ARRA BOND ALLOCATION?

Local agencies that received an allocation for the issuance of Recovery Zone Bonds (RZBs) or Qualified Energy Conservation Bonds (QECBs) by the U.S. Department of Treasury as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act must submit a Plan of Issuance outlining the planned use of that allocation. In California, the plans are required to be submitted to the California Debt Limit Allocation Committee (CD-LAC) by January 31, 2010.

According CDLAC, the Plan of Issuance should include a brief description of the project(s) to be funded, including the proposed qualifying project type, sponsor contact information, and anticipated bond amounts. Agencies should include with the plan a proposed timeline for all local actions and approvals (TEFRA, inducement resolution, etc.) and bond issuance. A list of the local approvals obtained to date and the anticipated construction start date for the project should also be included. For RZBs, a copy of the locally-approved Designation of Recovery Zone(s) resolution should also be submitted.

Following submission of the plan, local agencies must keep CDLAC apprised of any and all updates to the plan, including new or deleted projects or significant changes to a project's schedule. After July 1, 2010, allocations that have not been issued or

included in the (updated) Plan shall be automatically deemed waived and returned to CDLAC for re-allocation. If a local agency recipient does not intend to use its allocation, a recipient can return its award to CDLAC for re-allocation to other projects within the state. Local agencies who wish to waive their allocations are encouraged to send written confirmation to CD-LAC as soon as possible.

It is anticipated that CDLAC will award its first re-allocations in spring 2010. Program contact information, including the QECB and RZB allocation waiver forms, can be found on the CDLAC website at www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdlac.

INCREASED BORROWING FUELS THE MUNI MARKET

Municipal bond activity for November 2009 was the third busiest November recorded. According to Thomson Reuters, public agencies sold 928 issues totaling \$37.76 billion in November, representing an increase of approximately 49.7 percent over the previous year.

This increased activity is attributable to two key occurrences: First, November 2008 had low issuance activity because of the freeze in the credit markets, with 713 issues totaling \$25.73 billion. Second, public agencies are facing large budget deficits and using debt, as opposed to raising taxes, to balance budgets.

With issuance activity on the rebound in 2009, it appears that total year activity will surpass \$400 billion a level achieved only in 2005 and 2007. Additional market information can be found at www.bondbuyer.com.

GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ISSUANCE BY MAJOR PROGRAM AREA 2009 (THROUGH NOVEMBER)



AUTHORIZED BUT UNISSUED GO BONDS BY TYPE OF MAJOR PROGRAM




lion in the current year to about \$10.1 billion in 2012-13. In subsequent years, provided the state issued no more debt, annual debt payments would hover between \$9.0 and \$10.5 billion through 2027-28.

To service this debt in the medium term, the Treasurer expects the state's General Fund debt payments to rise by more than 30 percent, from 6.9 percent of General Fund resources to over 9.2 percent. Please see Figure 4. As displayed in Figure 4, the debt ratio would peak at about 11.0 percent of resources in 2012-13, then fall to about 9.2 percent through 2014-15.



Submitting Investment Policies No Longer Required

Effective January 1, 2010, cities and counties are no longer required to submit investment policies nor investment reports to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC). Senate Bill 113 (Chapter 332, Statutes of 2009) deleted California Government Code Section 53646, which required the submission of investment policies. The investment report submittal requirement was deleted in 2007.

SELECTED REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Under existing law (California Government Code Section 8855(k)), "The issuer of any proposed new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation incorporated for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 30 days prior to the sale of any debt issue at public or private sale, give written notice of the proposed sale to the Commission, by mail, postage prepaid."

Under California Government Code Section 8855(I), "The issuer of any new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 45 days after the signing of the bond purchase contract in a negotiated or private financing, or after the acceptance of a bid in a competitive offering, submit a report of final sale to the commission by mail, postage prepaid, or by any other method approved by the commission. A copy of the official statement for the issue shall accompany the report of final sale. The Commission may require information to be submitted in the report of final sale that is considered appropriate."

Under California Government Code Section 53583(c)(2)(B) if a "local agency determines to sell the (refunding) bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis, the local agency shall send a written statement, within two weeks after the bonds are sold, to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission explaining the reasons why the local agency determined to sell the bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis instead of at public sale."
