


CUMULATIVE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC DEBT ISSUANCE (IN BILLIONS)



CALIFORNIA PUBLIC DEBT ISSUANCE, AUGUST (IN MILLIONS)




STATE* VERSUS LOCAL DEBT ISSUANCE, AUGUST (IN MILLIONS)



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DODD-FRANK REFORM ACT CALENDAR OF EVENTS

Below are the following MSRB or SEC events and activities related to the implementation of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act.¹

UPDATES FOR SEPTEMBER

- MSRB added several key resources to its online "toolkit" of educational materials for state and local governments to help them improve their understanding of the municipal securities market.
- MSRB announced that it enhanced the market statistics available on the Electronic Municipal Market Access (EMMA), which includes monthly data on new issuance of municipal securities as reported to the MSRB.
- MSRB made available free online training videos to assist municipal securities dealers and issuers in making primary market and continuing disclosure submissions to EMMA website.
- 21 SEC approved amendments to MSRB Rule G-34 relating to use of the term "not reoffered" for new issues of municipal securities. The rule change will be effective as of November 1, 2012.

OCTOBER

- 2 MSRB and the Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association (SIFMA) cohosted a municipal securities regulation seminar for municipal market participants in New York City.
- MSRB and the Bond Dealers of America (BDA) will hold a municipal securities regulation seminar for all market participants in Chicago, Illinois.

TOP MUNICIPAL MARKET FINANCING TEAM PARTICIPANTS, JANUARY 1 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2012

Based on the public debt issuance information submitted to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) for bonds issued from January 1st through June 30th, state and local agencies issued approximately \$32.5 billion in long-term debt and short-term financing, a 66.9 percent increase from the \$19.5 billion issued in the first six months of 2011.¹

Bond Counsels

Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP (Orrick) was the leading bond coun-

sel firm based upon the volume of debt sold by California state and local agencies from January 1st to June 30th. Orrick held the same position during the same period last year. The firm served as bond counsel on California deals with a par value of \$14.6 billion, approximately 45 percent of the total issuance in which a bond counsel participated. The top five bond counsel firms for California public debt issuance are identified in Figure 1. Two other firms ranked highly on the California list, Fulbright & Jaworski LLP and Sidley Austin LLP, are also in the top ten nationwide, occupying the eighth and fifth spots respectively.2 Less than 1 percent of the deals in California, measured in volume, did

not include participation by a bond counsel firm.

Financial Advisors

Participation by financial advisors on bond sales in California, unlike the participation of bond counsel, is not uniform. Based on volume, financial advisors participated on approximately 73 percent of public debt issuance in January through June, 2012, an increase from the 69 percent of deals they participated in during the same period in 2011. Public Resources Advisory Group participated on 24 percent of the deals, climbing to first place in the first half of 2012. Montague DeRose and Associates, LLC was ranked in second place with 14 percent of volume.

KNN Public Finance, Public Financial Management, Inc., and Fieldman Rolapp & Associates round out the top five in that order. (Figure 2).

Underwriters

During the first six months of 2012, underwriters have purchased approximately 92 percent of the state's municipal offerings.³ This year's first and

second place firms, J.P. Morgan Securities LLC and Morgan Stanley & Co., occupied the same positions in 2011, underwriting more than 25 percent of the total debt issued in the state for the first half of both years. Goldman Sachs & Company made it into the top five during the first half of this year, underwriting almost 9 percent of California's debt. Over the past two years the top five underwriters have underwritten at

least 52 percent of California's state and local debt (Figure 3).

CDIAC relies on the accuracy of the information submitted on the Report of Final sale to analyze market trends for California public issuers. Most of the information noted above can be accessed through CDIAC's searchable online Debt Issuance Database, www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac.





CDIAC Debt Issuance Primer- Request for Proposal

CDIAC has issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to select qualified multi-disciplinary team(s) composed of individuals possessing expertise in municipal finance acquired as financial advisors, public finance attorneys, underwriters, and other municipal finance experts, to provide an in-depth analysis and review of the existing Debt Issuance Primer (Primer) and Debt Issuance Handbook, make recommendations on how best to update the Primer to provide the most effective tool for California municipal finance professionals (Needs Assessment), and complete the update and revision of the Primer (Update and Revision).

It is anticipated that a complete and updated Primer and Debt Issuance Handbook will be published and available in hard copy and electronic format by December 31, 2013. Other key dates related to the RFP process include:
