

CALIFORNIA PUBLIC DEBT ISSUANCE, NOVEMBER (IN MILLIONS)




STATE* VERSUS LOCAL DEBT ISSUANCE, NOVEMBER (IN MILLIONS)



DODD-FRANK REFORM ACT CALENDAR OF EVENTS

Below are the following MSRB or SEC events and activities related to the implementation of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act.¹

UPDATES TO NOVEMBER 2012

- MSRB announced it will host three education and outreach events for municipal market professionals in 2013. All outreach events will provide an opportunity for industry professionals to learn about what the MSRB is doing to protect investors and state and local governments. Events will be held on January 22, 2013 (Los Angeles, CA), March 7, 2013 (Dallas, TX), and July 23, 2013 (Boston, MA).
- MSRB announced that it will extend the implementation date of the inter-dealer regulatory dollar price reporting requirement to no later than March 29, 2013.

UPDATES TO DECEMBER 2012

- MSRB announced its improvements to the bid-to-cover ratios calculation for auction rate securities. The improvement provides a ratio that is more consistent with bid-to-cover ratios calculated for Treasury auction results.
- MSRB announced request for comment on a concept proposal to require underwriters to submit preliminary official statements to the MSRB's electronic municipal market access (EMMA*) system. Comments are due February 8, 2013.

JANUARY 2013

MSRB will host an Education and Outreach Seminar in Los Angeles, CA. Topics include updates on the MSRB's rulemaking for dealers and advisors, the MSRB's recent municipal market transparency initiatives, and MSRB's expanded mission.

DATA-CORNER

A MONTHLY UPDATE FROM CDIAC'S DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS UNIT

ONLINE FILING FORMS

The State Treasurer's Office (STO) recently updated its website to the Internet Explorer 9 (IE9) environment. This update caused some unforeseen problems with the online submittal of CDIAC reports. If the submitter did not have IE9 web browser installed on their computer, they may have experienced some or all of the following problems:

- 1. Inability to print the PDF copy of their submittal,
- 2. Missing data on their forms,
- 3. Erroneous entries
- 4. Inability to confirm submission of their report.

The CDIAC Data Unit has been working with the Treasurer's Information Technology Division (IT) to resolve these issues. IT has posted new versions of the Report of Proposed Debt Issuance and Report of Final Sale. Although the new reports are still in the IE9 environment, they are formatted to accept submittals from previous versions of IE as well as other web browsers.

We appreciate the patience of our filers as we work to resolve the submittal problems and request your feedback on the fixes that we have put into place. OUTSTANDING ISSUE (OIL) LETTERS

California Government Code requires issuers of public debt to submit a report of final sale (RFS) to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) no later than 45 days after the sale.1 If CDIAC does not receive the RFS within the required timeframe, CDIAC's Data Unit staff will send an OIL letter to the filing contact listed on the Report of Proposed Debt Issuance (RPDI) to request sale status.² At that time filers may notify CDIAC of the sale's cancellation, update the proposed sale date, or submit the RFS and accompanying bond sale documents³.

As we reach the end of the calendar year and prepare to balance our books in preparation for our annual report, it is very important that CDIAC account for all debt scheduled for issuance in 2012. To do so, CDIAC will begin sending OIL letters to filing contacts and issuers who have not submitted an RFS within the required time period. A second OIL letter will be sent if the filer fails to respond within 30 days of the first letter. Thirty days later a third OIL letter will be sent if the filer still has not responded. If the filer has not responded within 30 days of the third OIL letter, CDIAC will notify both the filing contact and the issuer of its intention to cancel the issue in the CDIAC database. This will require the issuer to submit a new RPDI if the sale does ultimately occur.

Please don't ignore your OIL letter. An email to CDIAC_Issuance@treasurer. ca.gov can be used to cancel or update the sale date.

¹ California Government Code Section 8855(j) requires issuers of any new state and local debt to submit a report of final sale to the commission no later than 45 days after the signing of the bond purchase contract in a negotiated or private financing or acceptance of a bid in a competitive offering.

² California Government Code Section 8855(i) requires issuers of any new state and local debt to report the intended sale of that debt to the commission no later than 30 days prior to public or private sale.


³ California Government Code Section 8855(j) requires issuers to submit a copy of the official statement with the RFS. If not official statement was prepared, the issuer shall submit other disclosure documents if they exist.


TIMELINESS OF SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS
