








## DODD-FRANK REFORM ACT CALENDAR OF EVENTS

Below are current MSRB or SEC events and activities related to the implementation of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.<sup>1</sup>

### UPDATES TO MARCH

- **3** SEC adopted revisions to the Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval System (EDGAR) Filer Manual and related rules to update the system. The revisions are being made primarily to introduce new submission form types to support the registration of Municipal Advisors.
- 7 SEC approved the MSRB's request to consolidate extensive interpretive guidance on the fair-practice obligations of municipal securities dealers, resulting in the adoption of Rule G-47 on Time-of-Trade Disclosure Obligations, MSRB Rules D-15 and G-48 on Sophisticated Municipal

### Market Professionals, and revisions to MSRB Rule G-19 on Suitability of Recommendations and Transactions.

**17** MSRB requests public comment on draft amendments to establish professional requirements for municipal advisors. The draft amendments would affect MSRB Rules G-1, G-2, G-3, and D-13. Comments are due May 16, 2014.

### UPDATES TO APRIL

28 Comments are due to the SEC on the asset-backed securities proposed release and the re-proposal of shelf eligibility conditions for assetbacked securities.

### MAY

27 Comments are due to the SEC on the proposed rule to amend Rule 17Ad-22 and add Rule 17Ab2-2 of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule would establish standards for the operation and governance of certain types of registered clearing agencies.





REPORTS OF PROPOSED DEBT ISSUANCE (RPDIs)\* RECEIVED MARCH 2014



## Top Municipal Market Financing Team Participants

### CALENDAR YEAR 2013

California state and local agencies issued approximately \$65 billion of long-term and short-term debt in calendar year 2013 - a 3.7 percent decrease from  $2012.^{1}$  This decrease was not as sharp as the 12.5 percent decrease reported nationwide in  $2013.^{2}$ 

### **Bond Counsels**

As was the case in 2012, Best Best & Krieger (BBK) was California's leading bond counsel firm in 2013, when measured in number of deals. BBK has acted as bond counsel to two local public agencies in the issuance of bonds under the Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Program.<sup>3</sup> PACE allows a local public agency to issue loans to individual property owners for the purpose of energy efficiency improvements and to collateralize those loans into bonds which are repaid through voluntary contractual assessments with the property owners. One of these local agencies, a joint powers authority, issues around 100 individual loans on a weekly basis. With the financing consisting of loans to individuals, principal amounts are low, but thousands of such loans translates into dozens of reports submitted to CDIAC. BBK was responsible for 18.4 percent of deals that used a bond counsel. Stradling, Yocca, Carlson & Rauth was second with 18.0 percent

of the deals. Orrick Herrington & Sutcliffe, Jones Hall, and Quint & Thimmig rounded out the top five firms in 2013 on a deal basis. These same five firms occupied the top five rankings in 2012.

Ranking of bond counsel firms by par amount issued produced an entirely different result. Orrick was by far the leading firm in California. In fact, deals on which Orrick was bond counsel accounted for over \$33 billion – more than all other bond counsel firms combined. Stradling Yocca Carlson & Rauth and Jones Hall finished second and third, respectively. BBK dropped back to eleventh based on par value.

Bond counsels participated in 99.1 percent of deals in California during 2013, a slight increase from the 98.4 percent during 2012.

### **Financial Advisors**

California's top financial advisory firm in 2013, based on deal count, was Public Financial Management (PFM). PFM held on to the top spot in 2013 by participating in 302 deals, a slight decrease from the 339 deals they participated in during 2012. PFM acts as financial advisor on the PACE financings which has increased the number of deals in which they participate. Fieldman, Rolapp & Associates; KNN Public Finance (KNN); Isom Advisors/Urban Futures; and Keygent Advisors rounded out the top five financial advisory firms on a deal basis for 2013.

Public Resources Advisory Group (PRAG) was California's top financial advisory firm in 2013 when measured by par amount, participating in 37

deals with a total par amount of \$13.8 billion. Montague DeRose & Associates, KNN, PFM, and Fieldman Rolapp complete the top five on a par amount basis.

Based on number of deals, financial advisors participated in 74 percent of public debt issuance during 2013, a rate virtually unchanged from 2012. Based upon par amount issued, financial advisory firms participated in eighty-one (81) percent of the debt issued in calendar year 2013. This represented a two (2) percent increase over 2012.

### Underwriters

Stifel Nicolaus & Company, Inc. (formerly Stone & Youngberg) with 169 deals, and Piper Jaffray & Co. with 117 deals were California's top two underwriting firms in 2013, as measured by number of deals. These firms maintained their rankings from 2012.

JP Morgan Securities eclipsed all other underwriting firms on a par value basis by purchasing nearly 25 percent of California's deals involving an underwriter. These deals, 24 in total, represented a par value of approximately \$14.6 billion. During 2013, underwriters purchased approximately 90 percent of the state's municipal offerings by par amount.<sup>4</sup> No participation by an underwriter was reported on 764 deals totaling approximately \$6.5 billion in par value.

CDIAC relies on the accuracy of the information submitted on the Report of Final sale to analyze market trends for California public issuers. Most of the information noted above can be accessed through CDIAC's searchable online Debt Issuance Database, www. treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac/debt.asp.
