


#### STATE\* VERSUS LOCAL DEBT ISSUANCE, MAY (IN MILLIONS)1







# SB 1029 Compliance: Adoption of Local Debt Policies


Senate Bill 1029, Hertzberg (Chapter 307, Statutes of 2016) amended Government Code section 8855(i) and went into effect on January 1, 2017. The amended section requires local issuers of public debt to certify prior to issuance that they have adopted policies concerning the use of debt that include specific elements and that the proposed issuance is consistent with those policies.

The local agency's debt policy must include the following five elements:

- A) The purposes for which the debt proceeds may be used;
- B) The types of debt that may be issued;
- C) The relationship of the debt to, and integration with, the issuer's capital improvement program or budget, if applicable;
- D) Policy goals related to the issuer's planning goals and objectives;
- E) The internal control procedures that the issuer has implemented, or will implement, to ensure that the proceeds of the proposed debt issuance will be directed to the intended use.

The certification of adopted debt policies must be made on the Report of Proposed Debt Issuance (Report of Proposed) that is submitted to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) thirty days prior to issuance. The Report of Proposed includes the following statement: "The issuer certifies that it has

complied with GC section 8855(i) with respect to local debt policies." There are three possible selections, "YES", "NO", and "NA". The submitter checks a box next to the appropriate response.

A"YES" response to this statement indicates that they have adopted local debt policies per section 8855(i) (1). "NO" responses indicate that they cannot certify that such policies have been adopted. Issuers that are not issuing local debt, such as the State of California or its departments or instrumentalities, may respond "NA" because the statute pertaining to debt policies applies only to local agencies. If the issuer is a conduit issuer (such as a joint powers authority issuing on behalf of another local public agency as the obligor), a "YES" response may mean that the issuer is certifying compliance with all of the debt policy elements or that it is relying, in part, on a certification by the local governmental obligor that it has adopted debt policies that comply with the required elements of 8855(i).

CDIAC has tracked the responses to the local debt policy question since the requirement went into effect on January 1, 2017. After adjusting for reports indicating "NA", 906 total Reports of Proposed were received from local debt issuers between January 1 and April 30, 2017. Just over 22 percent of the 906 certified that a compliant local debt policy was in place at the time the debt was proposed. (Figure 1).

During the first four months of 2017, the type of debt instrument most frequently reported to CDIAC by local agencies was the special assessment bond. This result is largely attributed to property assessed clean energy program financings. Of the 480 reports of proposed special assessment bond issuance received, only 7 percent certified that a local debt policy was in place. Reports of Proposed for general obligation (GO) bonds, the second most frequently reported debt type, included 82 affirmative debt policy

certifications, nearly 44 percent after adjusting for reports indicating "NA" (Figure 2).

CDIAC recognizes that many local agencies may have required time to develop debt policies or ensure that the debt polices already in place meet the requirements of the new legislation. CDIAC expects to see the level of certification improve when this topic is revisited at year end.
