


CUMULATIVE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC DEBT ISSUANCE (IN BILLIONS)1









Six Month Comparison of Debt Issuance 2017 vs. 2018

DATA AS OF 7/19/18

According to reports submitted to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission pursuant to Government Code section 8855, public debt issuance decreased by 29.9 percent over the first two quarters of 2018. State and local agencies issued \$33.4 billion during this period, down from \$47.6 billion in 2017 (Figure 1). U.S. municipal issuance stands at \$161 billion as of June 30, 2018.

Figure 2 provides a monthly comparison, 2017 to 2018, of debt issuance in California.



January and February recorded the lowest levels of issuance during the first six months of 2018. January's totals were 58 percent lower than January 2017 while February 2018 numbers were 32 percent lower than 2017.


Total long-term issuance in California decreased by 32.5 percent from \$42.1 billion in the first half of 2017 to \$28.4 billion in the first half of 2018 (Figure 3). This decrease can be directly associated with the drop-off in refundings, which declined by 60.8 percent year-over-year from \$20.2 to \$7.9 billion. Moreover, long-term refunding issuance as a percentage of total long-term issuance is down to 27.1 percent in 2018 compared with 47.1 percent in 2017.

New money issuance by state agencies increased modestly, with a 6.7 percent gain in the first half of 2018. Local agencies, however, issued 10.6 percent less new money in the first of half of 2018 than in the same period in 2017. Local refundings declined by nearly 69 percent while State refunding issuance decreased by 48.9 percent (Figure 4).

In the first six months of 2018, financings for Capital Improvements and

Public Works was the top purpose for which state and local agencies issued debt. Financings for Hospitals and Health Care Facilities and Education also declined. Financing for Housing and Other purposes were the only categories to experience gains (Figure 5).²

Significant changes can also be seen when total issuance data is broken down by debt type. Only three of the eleven debt types showed a year-over-year increases from 2017 to 2018. Certificates of participation issuance increased by 20.6 percent



from 2017 to 2018, conduit revenue bonds increased by 15 percent, and commercial paper increased by 6.2 percent. The sharpest decrease was associated with conduit revenue bonds, dropping by more than 72 percent. Tax allocation bonds also showed a dramatic decrease of 62.9 percent. (Figure 6).

In 2017, despite a national decline in issuance, California experienced

a 9.8 percent year-over-year gain in total issuance. As the market re-calibrates to accommodate changes under the new tax law - specifically a ban on advance refunding bonds - 2018 U.S. issuance volume is down 53.5% in January, 36.1% in February, 23.7% in March, 3.9% in April, 20.1% in May, and 19.4% in June.³ In California, CDIAC is tracking some \$9.4 billion of proposed state

and local debt set to be issued before the close of calendar 2018.


