Background

As part of the 2015-16 Budget Package, the California Legislature tasked the California Alternative Energy and Advanced Transportation Financing Authority (“CAEATFA”), in consultation with the California Public Utilities Commission, with creating a working group to develop criteria for a comparative assessment of energy efficiency financing programs available in California, including Property Assessed Clean Energy (“PACE”) financing, legacy utility on bill financing (“OBF”), and the California Hub for Energy Efficiency Financing (“CHEEF”) pilot programs.
