

CALIFORNIA PUBLIC DEBT ISSUANCE, MAY (IN MILLIONS)1




STATE* VERSUS LOCAL DEBT ISSUANCE, MAY (IN MILLIONS)1



A MONTHLY UPDATE FROM CDIAC'S DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS UNIT

Electronic Submission of Reporting Forms

Assembly Bill 2274 (Statutes of 2014, Chapter 181, Section 2), which took effect on January 1, 2015, amended several sections of the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission's statute. 1 Specifically, the bill removed any reference to the signing of a bond purchase contract or acceptance of a bid as a condition of submitting a report of final sale from Section 8855(j). AB 2274 also amended the method of submittal for both the report of proposed debt issuance and the report of final sale. Prior to January 1, 2015, Sections 8855(i) and (j), allowed issuers to submit these reports by mail, postage prepaid, or any other method approved by the commission. The method of submittal has been

amended by removing the mail option and now reads "by any method approved by the commission".


Beginning January 1, 2016, all reports must be filed electronically on the CDIAC website www.treasurer.ca.gov/cdiac/reporting.asp. CDIAC will no longer accept reports of proposed debt issuance or reports of final sale submitted by mail or as an attachment to an email. Both of these methods of submittal require manual entry of the reported data by CDIAC staff. Report volume has reached a level that manual entry of reports can no longer be supported by CDIAC staff.


TIMELINESS OF SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

² Under California Government Code Section 8855(j), "The issuer of any debt issue of state or local government, not later than 21 days after the sale of the debt, shall submit a report of final sale to the commission by any method approved by the commission. A copy of the final official statement for the issue shall accompany the report of final sale. The Commission may require information to be submitted in the report of final sale that is considered appropriate."

UPDATE TO MAY

MSRB received approval from the SEC to amend Rule G-14 on trade reporting, to collect additional post-trade data for display on its Electronic Municipal Market Access (EMMA) website.

UPDATES TO JUNE

- 1 MSRB made Moody's Investors Service, Inc. ratings available on EMMA.
- 2 GASB approved Statement No. 74, Financial Reporting for Postemployment Benefit Plans Other Than Pension Plans and Statement No. 75, Accounting and Financial Reporting for Postemployment Benefits Other Than Pensions. The provisions in Statement No. 74 are effective for fiscal years beginning after June 15, 2016, and the provisions of Statement No. 75 are effective for fiscal years beginning after June 15, 2017.
- MSRB added a feature to EMMA to allow access to the full universe of disclosures for each municipal security.

JULY

Comments are due to the MSRB on draft amendments to Rule A-3 that would modify the standard of independence for Board members.
