

NOTIFICATION OF EMERGENCY ACTION – SECOND READOPT

Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law, the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency to the Office of Administrative Law, the Office of Administrative Law shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6.

The California Health Facilities Financing Authority is hereby notifying you of its intent to resubmit the Investment in Mental Health Grant Program emergency regulations to the Office of Administrative Law in the next five working days or more. These emergency regulations were first adopted effective November 21, 2013 and readopted on May 15, 2014. Unless the emergency regulations are readopted for an additional 90-day period, the emergency regulations will lapse on August 14, 2014. The Request for Readoption of these regulations will extend the effective date of these emergency regulations for an additional 90 days thus ensuring that there will not be a gap in the effectiveness of the emergency regulations. The readoption will also provide the Authority the time necessary to complete the Rulemaking Process.
