Children's Hospital Program Annual Reports to the Legislature

February 25, 2016

Attached are the 2015 annual reports for the Children's Hospital Program of 2004 and the Children's Hospital Program of 2008, prepared in accordance with Section 16724.4 of the Government Code and sent to the Assembly, Senate, Legislative Counsel, and Department of Finance.

In summary, over \$1.3 billion in funding has been disbursed through these two programs to California's thirteen children's hospitals. More specifically, the Children's Hospital Program of 2004 has fully funded twelve of the thirteen hospitals. The Children's Hospital Program of 2008 has fully funded six of the thirteen children's hospitals. The remaining children's hospitals have until 2018 to draw down their funds.

In calendar year 2015, CHFFA awarded one grant award under the Children's Hospital Program of 2004 and three grant awards under the Children's Hospital Program of 2008. Additionally, approximately \$34 million in Children's Hospital Program of 2008 grant funds was disbursed to four children's hospitals in the 2015 calendar year.

Presently, six children's hospitals have open construction or equipment acquisition projects. Staff routinely monitors these projects through a variety of methods including site visits, emails, telephone calls, disbursement requests, news reports, and construction web cams.

2015 ANNUAL REPORT CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL PROGRAM OF 2004

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

On November 2, 2004, California voters passed Proposition 61 enabling the State of California to issue \$750 million in General Obligation bonds for the Children's Hospital Program. Under California Health and Safety Code, Sections 1179.10-1179.43, the purpose of the program is to improve the health and welfare of California's critically ill children, by providing a stable and ready source of funds for capital improvement projects for children's hospitals. The California Health Facilities Financing Authority (CHFFA) is responsible for administering the program.

Thirteen children's hospitals in California are eligible for funding. Eight are private nonprofit hospitals and five are University of California hospitals. Grant awards for non-University of California children's hospitals are limited to \$74 million, less costs of issuance. Grant awards for University of California children's hospitals are limited to \$30 million, less costs of issuance and administrative costs. Costs of issuance are \$0.75 per \$1,000 of the authorized grant award and administrative costs are \$5.00 per \$1,000 of the authorized grant award.

On November 4, 2008, California voters passed Proposition 3 enabling the State of California to issue \$980 million in General Obligation bonds for the Children's Hospital Program. Under California Health and Safety Code, Sections 1179.50-1179.72, the purpose of the program is to improve the health and welfare of California's critically ill children, by providing a stable and ready source of funds for capital improvement projects for children's hospitals. The California Health Facilities Financing Authority (CHFFA) is responsible for administering the program.

Thirteen children's hospitals in California are eligible for funding. Eight are private nonprofit hospitals and five are University of California hospitals. Grant awards for non-University of California children's hospitals are limited to \$98 million, less costs of issuance and administrative costs. Grant awards for University of California children's hospitals are limited to \$39.2 million, less costs of issuance and administrative costs. Costs of issuance are \$0.75 per \$1,000 of the authorized grant award and administrative costs are \$5.00 per \$1,000 of the authorized grant award.
