



CPCFA Announces New Opportunities for Electric Vehicle Charging Station Financing

The California Pollution Control Financing Authority (CPCFA) is pleased to offer an informational webinar and introduce a new webpage launching the CalCAP Electric Vehicle Charging Station (EVCS) Financing Program.

The California Energy Commission allocated \$2 million to the CalCAP EVCS Financing Program as a pilot, to support the expansion of California's electric vehicle charging infrastructure. The program aims to leverage public funds to attract private capital for the expansion and deployment of electric vehicle infrastructure in California. The CalCAP EVCS Financing Program, which is modeled after CPCFA's other very successful CalCAP programs, provides participating lenders with loan portfolio insurance to encourage the financing of electric vehicle charging stations while mitigating some of the risks associated with small business borrowers. One unique feature of this pilot program is that borrowers may be eligible to receive a rebate for installing charging stations.
