The Authority issued the Notes on April 29, 2016 in the aggregate principal amount of \$5,250,000 and is considering reissuing the Notes to modify certain terms relating to their repayment. A portion of the proceeds of the Notes in the amount of \$3,723,579 was used to finance the acquisition, construction, improvement, renovation, rehabilitation and/or installation of buildings, facilities and equipment, including trucks and other rolling stock, for the transport, handling, processing and/or recycling of solid wastes, located at 33377 Western Avenue, Union City, CA 94587 (the "Project"), and to pay associated costs of the financing. A portion of the proceeds of the Notes in the amount of \$1,526,421 was used to refund two prior series of the Authority's revenue notes issued on behalf of the Company in 2005 and 2007 (the "Refunded Bonds"). The Refunded Bonds were issued to finance costs similar to those for the Project at the same location. All financed assets are owned by the Company and/or an affiliate thereof.

Notice is further given that at said hearing all proponents and opponents of the proposed reissuance will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such Notes should be reissued.
