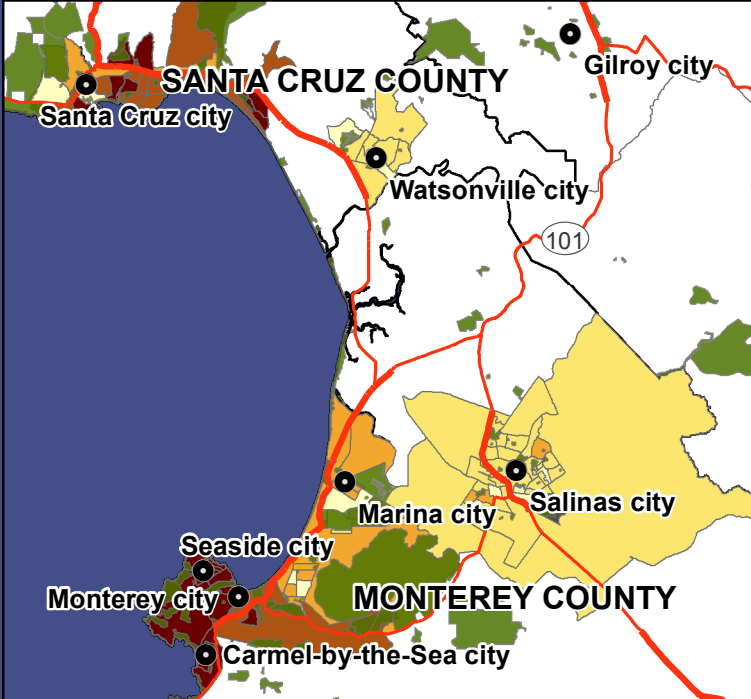


# 2018 TCAC/HCD OPPORTUNITY AREA MAP

This map displays the distribution of resources for all census tracts in the Central Coast geographic apportionment that **do not** qualify for the TCAC rural set-aside. Tract scores are based on education, economics and mobility, and environmental quality indicators, and are filtered by racial segregation and poverty concentration.
