Interested persons wishing to express their views on the proposed Regulations may do so at either public hearing, or may submit written comments to the TCAC at the above address **by 5:00 pm on Monday, August 31, 2015**. To allow all interested persons a reasonable opportunity to express their views, the Committee encourages the submission of written testimony. The hearing itself will consist of two sequential portions. The first portion will consist of TCAC staff summarizing the proposed substantive changes and answering clarifying questions regarding those proposed changes. The second portion will be the formal hearing wherein comments will be taken for the record. Oral remarks may be limited to no longer than five (5) minutes per person.

Action on the proposed amendments to the Qualified Allocation Plan and Regulations will be considered by TCAC at a meeting to be held subsequent to the hearing dates.
