Absent a Budget Solution – NOW

Private Sector Loses Billions

\$660 million a month for infrastructure projects disappears

- **\$4.62 billion through FY 2008-09**
- **\$12.5 billion through FY 2009-10**

Governor's Special Session Revenue Proposals

- **\$4.72 billion through FY 2008-09**
- **\$14.31 billion through FY 2009-10**





THE COST OF INACTION: LOST HIGHWAYS

- \$239 million bridge replacement on Interstate 5 in Shasta County.
- \$39 million for HOV lanes on Interstate 80 in Placer County.
- \$61 million for a two-lane HOV project on Highway 101 in Sonoma County.
- \$345 million tunnel project on Highway 24 in Alameda County.
- \$92 million to widen Highway 198 in Kings County.



THE COST OF INACTION: LOST HIGHWAYS

- **\$30 million to build a new interchange on Highway 1 in Monterey County.**
- **\$218 million HOV lane on I-5 in LA County.**
- **\$29 million to widen Highway 118 in Ventura County.**
- **\$37 million to replace bridges on Highway 99 in Merced County.**
- **\$65 million to add an eastbound lane on Highway 91 in Orange County.**
