**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The Minutes for the meeting of August 18, 2004, were approved as submitted, 3-0.

**APPROVAL OF PMIB DESIGNATION NO. 1663**

Mr. Doug Spittler of the State Treasurer's Office presented the portfolio Summary Report as of September 7, 2004. On that day, the portfolio stood at \$49.111 billion. The effective yield was 1.753%, the quarter-to-date yield was 1.649% and the year-to-date yield was 1.649%. The average life of the portfolio was 194 days and AB 55 Loans approved stood at \$4.678 billion with \$882 million having been disbursed. The Local Agency Investment Fund had deposits totaling \$20.116 billion with 2,740 participants.

Designation No. 1663 was approved, 3-0.

**APPROVAL OF SURPLUS MONEY DECLARATIONS/REDUCTIONS**

Mr. Doug Spittler presented the changes in the Surplus Money Investment Fund for the period August 1, 2004, through August 31, 2004. During that month \$8.940 billion was declared surplus in various special funds, while \$8.547 billion was declared to be a reduction in surplus. Mr. Spittler noted that the daily changes were listed on the attachment.

The Surplus Money Declaration/Reduction for the month of August 2004 was approved, 3-0.

**APPROVAL OF SURPLUS MONEY INVESTMENT FUND REQUESTS**

Mr. Doug Spittler presented two SMIF requests. The first request was from the California Energy Commission for the Energy Facility License and Compliance Fund (Fund Number 3062). The second request was from the Secretary of State for the Victims of Corporate Fraud

Compensation Fund (Fund Number 3042). Mr. Spittler said that staff had reviewed the requests and recommended their approval.

The Board accepted the staff's recommendations and approved both requests, 3-0.

**APPROVAL OF AB 55 LOANS**

Mr. Chris Kooyman of the Public Finance Division of the State Treasurer's Office presented the loan requests as shown in the following table. He noted that there were nineteen loans on the agenda but that item g. had been withdrawn resulting in eighteen loans for consideration. He indicated that loans a. through f. were for general obligation bond programs and that loans h. through s. were for lease revenue bond programs.
