California Capital Access Program (CalCAP) Notice of Final Approval of Permanent Regulations

The California Pollution Control Financing Authority (CPCFA) organized and operating pursuant to Sections 44500 through 44563 of the California Health and Safety Code has adopted the approved regulations after considering all comments, objections, and recommendations regarding the proposed action.

CPCFA amended Section 8070 of Title 4 of the California Code of Regulations (the "Proposed California Capital Access Regulations") concerning the administration of the Capital Access Program for Small Businesses (the "Program"). The Office of Administrative Law approved and filed these adopted regulations with the Secretary of State on July 26, 2012.

As of the date of this letter, all new loans submitted for consideration for enrollment in the Program must meet the regulatory requirements as prescribed in the California Capital Access Program Regulations.
