

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED FINANCING
BY THE CALIFORNIA SCHOOL FINANCE AUTHORITY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on January 29, 2026, the California School Finance Authority (the “Authority”) will hold a public hearing, as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), with respect to the proposed issuance and sale of revenue bonds in one or more series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$27,000,000 (collectively, the “Bonds”), on behalf of Orange Springs Facilities LLC (the “Borrower”), a California limited liability company, the sole member of which is Citrus Springs Charter School, Inc. (the “Lessee”), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

The proceeds of the Bonds are expected to be used to (1) finance and/or refinance the acquisition, construction, expansion, rehabilitation, renovation, furnishing and equipping of certain charter school educational facilities, including classroom and administrative spaces and related and appurtenant facilities, located at or adjacent to 1821-1823 North Grand Avenue, Santa Ana, California 92705 (collectively, the “Project”), (2) pay costs of issuance of the Bonds, and (3) fund all or a portion of a debt service reserve fund deposit, capitalized interest, related working capital, and a repair and replacement fund deposit. The Project will be owned by the Borrower, and will be operated as public charter school facilities. The Bonds will be issued as “qualified 501(c)(3) bonds” under Section 145 of the Code.

The hearing will commence at 9:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard and will be held at 901 P Street, Room 102, Sacramento, California 95814. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the Project proposed to be financed may attend the public hearing in person or by phone at the following number: (844) 767-5651 (participation code 8792019), or may, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments to Katrina M.
