NOTICE OF READOPTION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

The California Alternative Energy and Advanced Transportation Financing Authority ("Authority" or "CAEATFA") organized and operating pursuant to Division 16 (commencing with Section 26000) of the California Public Resources Code proposes to adopt the proposed emergency regulations after considering all comments, objections, and recommendations regarding the proposed action.

The regulations amend Section 10092 of Article 6 of Division 13 of Title 4 of the California Code of Regulations to introduce On-Bill Repayment and a simplified pathway for microloans under \$10,000 and to incorporate lessons learned from program implementation.

Government Code Section 11346.1(a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law, the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After the submission of the proposed emergency to the Office of Administrative Law, the Office of Administrative Law shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code Section 11349.6.

In accordance with its authority under Public Resources Code Section 26009, CAEATFA is proposing to readopt the regulation as emergency regulations. Attached to this Notice is the specific regulatory language of CAEATFA's proposed regulatory action and the Finding of Emergency.
