CDLAC Scoring and CIDFAC Fee Review Work Plan March 15, 2016

Purpose: CIDFAC staff proposes a review and possible revision of the current CDLAC scoring system for evaluating the public benefits of IDB projects for which tax-exempt allocation is requested and also to examine the current CIDFAC fee structure. The current scoring system was developed about seven years ago and the intent was to recognize and award IDB projects that contributed to the state's overall economic development, greening of the manufacturing sector and to help the state curb climate change emissions.

CIDFAC staff has been in contact with outside stakeholders who believe that the IDB scoring system needs to be updated to reflect the current state of manufacturing in California. Additionally, the stakeholders feel that the CIDFAC fee structure needs to be examined as well. CIDFAC staff in conjunction with CDLAC staff, plan to engage stakeholders through a workshop/webinar to identify what changes need to be made to either the IDB scoring system and/or fee structure and respond accordingly.

Goals: CIDFAC staff's goals are as follows:

- 1. To revise the point system as appropriate by the end of the 2016 calendar year.
- 2. To determine whether or not the current CIDFAC fee structure reasonably supports the operation of CIDFAC.

Meeting both of these goals will require significant collaborative efforts between CIDFAC and CDLAC staff through analysis and the rulemaking process.
