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Antioch Scattered Site Renovation Apartments is an existing scattered site project consisting of Terrace Glen Apartments and Pinecrest Apartments. Antioch Scattered Site Renovation is located on an aggregate 1.12 acre site. The project consists of 77 restricted rental units and 3 unrestricted managers' units. The project has 48 one-bedroom units, 25 two-bedroom units and 4 three-bedroom units. The renovations will include building exterior and interior upgrades. Building exterior renovations will consist of improved lighting, gutter repair, repair/replacement of fencing, drainage improvements, sewer line repairs and the addition of security gates. Interior renovations will include a new warming kitchen, services coordinator room and window replacements. Individual apartment units will be updated with replacement of heaters and air conditioners, addition of bathroom fans and replacement of some kitchens and bathrooms. Lastly, common or site area renovations will consist of ADA updates. Using Energy Star appliances and other energy conservation measures, each property will reduce its energy use by at least 5% with a minimum improvement of 10% across both projects. The rehabilitation is expected to begin at the end of 2018 and be completed at the end of 2019.
