#### **Investment in Mental Health Wellness Grant Program ("IMHWGP")**

**County of Los Angeles** 

**Quarterly Update** 

**December 6, 2018** 

The Authority approved a reinstatement of, and amendment to, Resolution Number MH 2014-06 on February 22, 2018 for an Investment in Mental Health Wellness grant for the County of Los Angeles ("the "County") in an amount not to exceed \$40,892,700.49 for 240 beds to serve adults in 15 new Crisis Residential Treatment Programs ("CRTP"), eight new beds in one expanded Crisis Stabilization Unit ("CSU"), aka Urgent Care Center ("UCC"), 14 mobile crisis support teams ("MCST") and one clerical staff to provide field based crisis intervention services to children, adolescents, and adults throughout the County.

As a condition of approval, the Authority required the County to provide quarterly updates detailing milestones achieved, progress, and obstacles or challenges related to the completion of the projects as described in the Authority resolution. The County provided its first and second quarterly updates in May 2018 and September 2018. The County's third quarterly update is summarized on the next page as well as in Exhibit 1.

# **DECEMBER 2018 QUARTERLY UPDATE:**

Below is a summary of the County's third quarterly update on the work that has been completed and upcoming milestones.

#### For all Campuses:

- Milestone date changes have been made due to site analysis, environmental review and the steering committee reviewing and refining deadlines.
- The County has met with the Contracts Division to discuss the process and timeline to procure CRTP service providers and are currently getting the necessary documents to issue a RFP by the summer of 2019.

# LAC+USC Campus:

- The design/build contract award date has been rescheduled from August 2019 to September 2019.
- The construction start date has been moved from October 2019 to January 2020. In the second quarterly update, the constructions start date was inaccurately reported as April 2019.
- The expected completion date has been moved from September 2020 to December 2020. In the second quarterly update, the expected completion date was inaccurately reported as August 2020.

#### **MLK Campus:**

- The Environmental Impact Review ("EIR") process is to be completed and the addendum to be certified by the Board of Supervisors on December 11, 2018.
- Meetings with the architect began on October 16, 2018.
- Demolition is still expected to begin in December 2018.
- The expected open and operational date has moved from October 2020 to January 2021.

#### Olive View Campus:

- As mentioned in September, there was a challenge in finalizing the site for the UCC due to its proximity to the existing helipad, which needed to be preserved. In partnership with Public Works and Health Services, the County found an alternative site on campus and the Environmental Impact Review ("EIR") addendum process has continued.
- Due to the change in site location, the EIR process for the UCC and CRTP was delayed and is now expected to be completed in May 2019 rather than December 2018.
- Additionally, the expected completion date for both the UCC and CRTP have been delayed five months from December 2020 to May 2021.

# Rancho Los Amigos Campus:

- Public Works identified that the location that was selected for the five CRTPs was not going to be ready in time for completion by December 2021. As a result, the County worked with the 4th District Board Office, CEO and Health Services to find an alternative site to build on the Rancho Los Amigos campus. The new site that was chosen is directly north of the previous location.
- Due to the change in site location, the EIR process was delayed but is currently in progress. The previously anticipated completion date of February 2019 has been deferred four months to June 2019.
- The anticipated award date for the design/build contract is expected to be September 2019.
- The CRTPs are now expected to be completed in one phase rather than two and are expected to be open and operational by May 2021 rather than September 2020 and March 2021.
