

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 29, 2022, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code (the “Code”) will be held by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority (the “Authority”) with respect to the proposed issuance by the Authority of its debt obligations in one or more series from time to time in an amount not to exceed \$20,000,000 (the “Obligations”). The proceeds of the Obligations will be used by Marin General Hospital, doing business as MarinHealth Medical Center (the “Corporation”), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, to finance and/or refinance costs incurred with the implementation of an electronic health record system (the “Project”) to be owned by the Corporation and accessed from the following locations, which are used as part of an integrated operation:

and to pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the execution and delivery of the Obligations.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m. (Pacific Time), or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held in Suite 435, 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California 95814.
