Notice is hereby given that on May 21, 2025, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") will be held by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority (the "Authority") with respect to the proposed issuance by the Authority of its qualified 501(c)(3) bonds, as defined in Section 145 of the Code for hospitals or other healthcare facilities, as one or more series of revenue bonds and one or more series of commercial paper revenue notes (hereinafter referred to as the "Tax-Exempt Obligations"), from time to time, pursuant to a plan of financing, for the benefit of Stanford Health Care (the "Borrower"), a nonprofit public benefit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, such Tax-Exempt Obligations to be issued in one or more series, from time to time, in an amount not to exceed \$1,275,000,000.

Proceeds of the Tax-Exempt Obligations will be used by the Borrower to finance the acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, furnishing and equipping (including by reimbursing expenditures made for such purposes) of:

- certain health care facilities owned and operated by the Borrower and located on the Stanford Health Care campus in Palo Alto and Stanford, California, at and in the vicinity of the area bounded by Welch Road, Quarry Road and Campus Drive, including, 300 Pasteur Drive, 500 Pasteur Drive, 875 Blake Wilbur Drive, 900 Blake Wilbur Drive, 211 Quarry Road, 401 Quarry Road, 700 Welch Road, 750 Welch Road, 770 Welch Road, 777 Welch Road, 780 Welch Road, 800 Welch Road, 801 Welch Road, 900 Welch Road, 1000 Welch Road, 1101 Welch Road and 1189 Welch Road (the "Campus") (Tax-Exempt Obligations in an amount not to exceed \$550,000,000); and
- certain health care and health care related administrative facilities owned and operated by the Borrower and located generally at 500 Broadway and 510 Broadway in Redwood City, California (Tax-Exempt Obligations proceeds in an amount not to exceed \$500,000,000).

Proceeds of the Tax-Exempt Obligations will also be used by the Borrower to refinance the acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, furnishing and equipping (including by reimbursing expenditures made for such purposes) of certain health care facilities owned and operated by the Borrower and located on the Campus (Tax-Exempt Obligations proceeds in an amount not to exceed \$225,000,000), and may also be applied to pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Tax-Exempt Obligations.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m. (Pacific Time), or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard and will be held in Room 313, 901 P Street, Sacramento, California 95814.
