## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on Wednesday, May 24, 2017, a public hearing will be held, as required by section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code"), with respect to the proposed issuance by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority of revenue bonds in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$55,000,000 (the "Bonds") relating to the financing and refinancing of projects for Montecito Retirement Association, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (the "Corporation").

The Bonds will be issued in part to (a) finance the construction of 22 new independent living, 6 personal care and 6 memory care units, enhanced infrastructure, an updated clinic facility, a new dining venue and road improvements, all with respect to the Corporation's facilities located at 300 Hot Springs Road, Montecito, California, known as Casa Dorinda, (b) refinance its obligations under a Second Installment Sale Agreement, dated as of March 1, 2012, by and between the Corporation and the County of Santa Barbara, executed to refinance the acquisition, construction and equipping of the Corporation's retirement facilities and, therefore, to provide for the redemption of certificates of participation executed and delivered in 2004 for the benefit of the Corporation, and (c) pay costs in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. The facilities listed will be owned and operated by the Corporation, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 A.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, and will be held, in Suite 435, 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California.
