## California Pollution Control Financing Authority The California Americans with Disabilities Small Business Capital Access Loan Program

This is a reminder that the CalCAP/ADA Program has new and exciting features since the adoption of the emergency regulations effective 12/21/2017. The changes expand the definition of "small business" and allow reimbursement to Borrowers for the cost of the Certified Access Specialist Report (CASp). Upon loan enrollment, a small business may be eligible for reimbursement, equal to up to 5% of the CalCAP/ADA enrolled loan amount, toward the cost of the CASp report. Additionally, the total annual gross income from all sources was raised from of less than \$1,000,000 to the now \$5,000,000.
