CARB PROPOSED FUNDING AND PILOT PROGRAM

- CARB is proposing allocating \$10 Million for the new Zero-Emission Truck Loan Pilot Program
- Coordinate with Energy Commission on infrastructure financing
- Continue to allocate funding to the current CalCAP/CARB truck program through 2023



CURRENT CALCAP/CARB TRUCK PROGRAM



Since 2009, CARB and CalCAP have operated the CARB Heavy-Duty Vehicle Air Quality Loan Program



As of December 31, 2021, CARB has allocated \$215.9 Million to the program



As of April 30, 2022:

36,639 loans enrolled in the program

Enrolled loan total of \$2,547,817,763.34

Contribution amount of \$202,733,749.10


SENATE BILL 372 — MEDIUM AND HEAVY-DUTY FLEET PURCHASING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM: ZERO EMISSION VEHICLES



Approved by Governor Newsom on October 7, 2021

Establishes the Medium- and Heavy-Duty Zero-Emission Vehicle Fleet Purchasing Assistance Program within the Air Quality Improvement Program

Goal is to make financing tools and nonfinancial supports available to operators of medium- and heavy-duty vehicle fleets to enable those operators to transition their fleets to zero-emission vehicles


