

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that a public hearing will be held before the Deputy Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority") or her designee on Thursday, September 13, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as such matters may be heard, in Room 470 of 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California, on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of revenue bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued from time to time (the "Bonds") for the benefit of Douglas E. Raisch ("Raisch") and Raisch Company, a California corporation (or any successor thereto) (the "Corporation") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$3,575,000 (collectively, the "Bonds").

Bond proceeds will be used to (1) finance the cost of certain waste recovery equipment and machinery and improvements to the Corporation's facilities located at 99 Pullman Way, San Jose, California 95111, 55 Hillsdale Avenue, San Jose, California 95136, 1444 Borregas Avenue, Sunnyvale, California 94089, and 7010 Auto Mall Parkway, Fremont, California 94538 (collectively, the "Facilities") (2) fund the cost of any insurance premium, letter of credit fees or other credit enhancement costs with respect to the financing, (3) pay capitalized interest with respect to the financing, (4) fund a reserve fund, if necessary, with respect to the financing and (5) pay certain costs of issuance in connection with the financing (collectively, the "Project"). The Facilities will be owned by Raisch and/or the Corporation and will be used and operated by the Corporation in its waste recovery operations.

Notice is further given that at said hearing all proponents and opponents of the Project and the proposed financing of the Project will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such Bonds should be issued. Written comments may also be submitted to the Authority prior to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 12, 2007, at the address listed below.
