

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority") or his designee on Friday, November 2, 2007, at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as such matters may be heard, in Room 470 of 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California, on the proposed issuance, pursuant to a plan of financing, of one or more series of revenue bonds (the "Bonds") by the Authority in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$31,960,000. The Bonds will be part of a plan of finance, which may occur over a period of years, and which will include projects located in several counties within the State, including the facilities described below.

A portion of such Bond proceeds is intended to finance the following projects in the County of San Diego:

All financed assets will be owned and/or operated by EDCO Disposal Corporation and/or an affiliate thereof (the "Company"). The vehicles and containers will be used to service the Company's customers throughout the Company's service territories in San Diego, San Bernardino, Los Angeles, Riverside, Orange and Imperial County, California, and the containers will be located at the addresses of the Company's customers.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the proposed financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such revenue bonds should be issued.
