

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority"), or her designee, on Thursday, April 20, 2017, at 10:00 a.m., California time, in Room 270, 801 Capitol Mall, 2nd Floor, Sacramento, California, on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of revenue notes in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$23,290,000.

Such note proceeds are intended to (A) finance or refinance the acquisition and installation, if any, of equipment for the collection, processing, transfer and recycling of solid waste, including rolling stock, collection vehicles, carts, pails, bins, containers and other equipment functionally related thereto, to be located at 3355 Thomas Road, Santa Clara, California 95054 (the "Thomas Road Site"), 301 Carl Road, Sunnyvale, California 94089 (the "Carl Road Site") and/or with customers in incorporated and unincorporated Santa Clara County, California (the "County"); and (B) refund two outstanding Authority revenue bonds issue which financed or refinanced (i) the acquisition of land, the acquisition and installation, if any, of equipment, rolling stock and vehicles for the collection, processing and transfer of solid waste and other equipment functionally related thereto located at the Thomas Road Site and/or the acquisition of drop boxes, bins, carts and containers located with customers throughout the County; and (ii) acquisition and installation, if any, of equipment, rolling stock and vehicles for the processing and transfer of solid waste, including without limitation, screens, conveyors, sorters, forklifts and loaders, and other equipment functionally related thereto, located at the Carl Road Site. All financed assets will be owned and/or operated by Bay Counties Waste Services, Inc. and/or an affiliate thereof.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the facilities or the possible financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such notes should be issued.
