

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority"), or her designee, on Friday, October 9, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., Pacific Time, in Room 270, 801 Capitol Mall, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Sacramento, CA 95814, on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of exempt facility notes for solid waste disposal facilities (the "Projects") pursuant to Section 142(a)(6) of the Code, in the maximum principal amount of \$42,500,000.

Such note proceeds are intended to finance or refinance the following Projects:

- (A) (i) the acquisition and installation, if any, of solid waste equipment to be located:
  - (1) at 1080, 1088 and/or 1090 Walsh Avenue, Santa Clara, California, 95050 ("Walsh Avenue"), which equipment will be owned by Garden City Sanitation, Inc. ("GCSI");
  - (2) at 1015 Martin Avenue, Santa Clara, California 95050 ("Martin Avenue"), which equipment will be owned by Milpitas Sanitation, Inc. ("MSI");
  - (3) and/or with customers in incorporated and unincorporated Santa Clara County, California, which equipment will be owned by GCSI or MSI;
- (ii) the construction of improvements to solid waste disposal and recycling facilities to be located:
  - (1) at Walsh Avenue, which improvements will be owned by Garden City Sanitation, LLC; and/or
  - (2) at Martin Avenue, which improvements will be owned by Livermore Sanitation, LLC ("LSLLC");

all such financed assets to be in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$25,000,000; and

- (B) (i) the acquisition and installation, if any, of solid waste equipment to be located at 7000 and/or 7050 National Drive, Livermore, California 94550 ("National Drive") and/or with customers in incorporated and unincorporated Alameda County, California, which equipment will be owned by Livermore Sanitation, Inc.; and

- (ii) the construction of improvements to solid waste disposal and recycling facilities to be located at National Drive, such improvements to be owned by LSLLC;

all such financed assets to be in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$21,000,000.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the facilities or the

possible financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such notes should be issued.
