

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority"), or her designee, on Friday, October 9, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., Pacific Time, in Room 270, 801 Capitol Mall, 2nd Floor, Sacramento, CA 95814, on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of exempt facility notes for solid waste disposal facilities (the "Projects") pursuant to Section 142(a)(6) of the Code, in the maximum principal amount of \$25,000,000.

Such note proceeds are intended to finance or refinance (i) the acquisition and installation, if any, of solid waste equipment to be located at 1060 Richard Avenue, Santa Clara, CA 95052 (the "Site") and/or with customers in incorporated and unincorporated Santa Clara County, California, and (ii) the construction of improvements to solid waste disposal and recycling facilities to be located at the Site, in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$25,000,000. All financed assets will be owned by Mission Trail Waste Systems, Inc. or Santa Clara Valley Industries, LLC.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the facilities or the possible financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such notes should be issued.
