

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED FINANCING  
BY THE CALIFORNIA SCHOOL FINANCE AUTHORITY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 24, 2021, the California School Finance Authority (the “Authority”) will hold a public hearing, as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, with respect to the proposed issuance and sale of revenue bonds, pursuant to a plan of financing and in one or more series from time to time, on behalf of Granada Hills Charter, a nonprofit public benefit corporation and operator of a public charter school (“Granada Hills Charter”) and/or 17081 Devonshire LLC, a limited liability company, whose sole member is Granada Hills Charter (the “Borrower”), in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$16,000,000 (collectively, the “Bonds”).

The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to (1) finance and/or refinance the acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, improvement, furnishing and/or equipping (the “Project”) of the charter school educational facilities known as Granada Hills Charter Devonshire Campus, located at 17081 Devonshire Street, Northridge, California 91325 (the “Devonshire Campus”), (2) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds, and (3) fund a debt service reserve fund and a repair and replacement fund with respect to the Bonds. The Devonshire Campus is owned by the Borrower and operated as a public charter school by Granada Hills Charter. Upon completion of the Project, Granada Hills Charter is expected to have the capacity for approximately 1,425 students in grades TK through 8 and 500 students in grades 9 through 12 at the Devonshire Campus.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m., local time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held at 915 Capitol Mall, Room 587, Sacramento, California 95814. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the facilities and Project proposed to be financed may attend the public hearing in person or by phone at (844) 867-6169 (participation code 2747976), or may, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments to Katrina M.
