(the "Borrower"), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, for any or all of the following purposes: (a) to finance and/or refinance the acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, improvement, furnishing and/or equipping of certain educational facilities located at 26655 Highland Avenue, Highland, California 92346 (the "Facilities"); (b) to fund any reserve funds, capitalized interest and/or related working capital with respect to the Bonds, if necessary; and (c) to pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds (such purposes are referred to herein collectively as the "Project"). The Facilities are or will, upon acquisition, be owned by Real Journey Properties, LLC, a California limited liability company whose sole member is the Borrower, and will be leased to and operated by the Charter School for the conduct of public charter education.

The Public Hearing is intended to comply with the public approval requirements of Section 147(f) of the Code.
