

RESOLUTION NO. 23-36

APPROVAL OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL FACILITIES CREDIT ENHANCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM (CFDA #84.354A) AWARD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,000 TO PATHWAYS TO COLLEGE PROPERTIES, LLC ON BEHALF OF CROSSWALK: HESPERIA EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING PATHWAYS FOR PATHWAYS TO COLLEGE K8

WHEREAS, on behalf of the State of California, the California School Finance Authority (Authority) applied for and was awarded a \$2,000,000 grant through the United States Department of Education entitled the Charter Access to Bank Loan Enhancement (Charter ABLE) Program (CFDA # 84.354A); and

WHEREAS, the Authority will award and administer Charter ABLE funds for the benefit of California charter school awardees to fund the primary debt service reserve requirement for debt issued by or through the Authority for an awardee to acquire, renovate, and/or construct school facilities, or refinance existing charter school facility debt to reduce overall borrowing costs; and

WHEREAS, Pathways to College Properties, LLC, requested an award under Charter ABLE (Application) on behalf of Crosswalk: Hesperia Experiential Learning Pathways and their Pathways to College K8 campus (Project), and the Application was deemed eligible for a Charter ABLE award; and

WHEREAS, the Authority will allocate funds for the benefit of Pathways to College Properties, LLC, for a total allocation amount not to exceed \$2,000,000. If funding is exhausted in Charter ABLE but available in another of the Authority's credit enhancement programs, funds may be awarded from another credit enhancement program's available funds, providing the awardee is eligible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the California School Finance Authority as follows.

Section 1. Pathways to College Properties, LLC (Awardee) on behalf of Crosswalk: Hesperia Experiential Learning Pathways, is hereby awarded a credit enhancement award under the Charter School Facilities Credit Enhancement Grant Program (California Code of Regulations, title 4, §10192 et seq.) (Program) in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000. The Executive Director of the Authority is hereby authorized and directed to do all things that they may deem necessary or advisable to assist the Awardee with the completion of a transaction, including providing assistance and cooperation in the credit rating process and making a request to the Authority for the issuance, sale, and delivery of bonds as may be needed to implement this Resolution.

Section 2. The Executive Director of the Authority is further authorized to take the following actions: (1) take all steps necessary with respect to the Awardee including notifying the Awardee whether its Application has been approved for funding, preparing and executing the final form of the Program agreement, and disbursing funds pursuant to the Program agreement and the Authority's regulations; (2) approve changes to the Project when necessary and authorized under the Authority's regulations; provided that the amount of the credit enhancement award may not be increased above the amount approved by the Authority; (3) draw money from the Authority's funds, not to exceed the amount approved by the Authority for the benefit of the Awardee; (4) execute and deliver to the Awardee any and

all documents necessary to complete the transfer of funds; and (5) undertake any and all actions and to execute and deliver any and all documents that the Executive Director deems necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution approved by the Authority.

Section 3. Nothing in this Resolution constitutes an agreement or commitment on the part of the Authority to issue conduit bonds for the benefit of the Awardee.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and remain in full force and effect thereafter; provided that this Resolution shall cease to be effective six months after the adoption date unless prior to such date the Authority specifically adopts a further resolution extending the effective date of this initial Resolution.
