RE: 2022 HUD Tenant Demographic Data Collection

2022 Tenant Demographic Data Collection

The California Tax Credit Allocation Committee (CTCAC) would like to provide an update to project owners and management companies on CTCAC's efforts to comply with California's Tenant Demographic Data Collection requirements. In 2023, CTCAC's contractor will continue to be Spectrum Enterprises.

For all Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) households, the data requested shall be as of December 31, 2022. For example, if a household occupied a unit on December 31, 2022, the data reported to Spectrum shall be from either the Initial or Move-In certification that occurred in 2022 or the most recent recertification that was completed for the household in 2022. If the unit was vacant on December 31, 2022 the certification type would be set to Move-Out or Transfer-Out and no further documentation is required.

In Notices 2022-05 and 2022-52, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) did not provide any further recertification waivers for tax credit households, therefore all 2022 household recertification data shall be submitted to Spectrum.

Data Submission Schedule

The final deadline for the submission of 2022 data to Spectrum is March 16, 2023. Failure to submit the data to Spectrum by the required deadline may result in assessment of a fine to the project owner.

In order to submit the tenant data for the 2022 data collection cycle, you must use the same Spectrum software previously downloaded and installed to complete the 2021 data collection cycle. There have

been no changes made to the software. If the software is still installed on your computer(s), simply start as you did last year and it will be automatically updated for the 2022 collection cycle on January 1, 2023. If you do not have the Spectrum software currently installed at your site, you may install it from Spectrum's website at: <http://www.spectrumlihtc.com/states/california/>

It is essential that project owners and property management staff submit the data using the correct Building Identification Number (BIN) formatting. CTCAC requires the BINs in the following format:

Consistent with the IRS, the BINs are designated by CTCAC as CA-YY-PPPNN where the YY represents the last 2 digits of the allocation year, the PPP represents the CTCAC project application ID and the NN represents the building number within the project (01, 02, 03, etc.).
