The Road Ahead: Will Boom Turn To Bust

The U.S. economy has experienced unprecedented rates of economic and job creation coming out of the pandemic recession, but it has come along with an unwelcome side-effect of the worse supply-chain disruptions and highest consumer inflation in more than 40 years. Today government COVID relief spending is fading fast and the Powell "put" is no longer in-effect as it tries to slow demand to bring down inflation without triggering an outright recession. Geopolitical conflicts including a war in Europe and a China zero-COVID policy complicate the economic picture. Cracks are now appearing in consumer confidence, stock market valuation, the technology sector and housing demand. This presentation will explore where all this may be headed in the quarters ahead, and the rising risk of recession.
