

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on August 26, 2026, a public hearing as required by section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 will be held by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority (the “Authority”) with respect to the proposed issuance by the Authority of its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$14,000,000 (the “Bonds”).

The Bonds will be issued as “qualified 501(c)(3)” bonds pursuant to Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”). The proceeds of the Bonds will be used by Castle Family Health Centers, Inc. (the “Corporation”) as follows: (a) up to \$12,500,000 to finance the design, construction, installation, and equipping of an expansion of the Corporation’s clinic located at 1775 Third Street in the City of Atwater, California, to add approximately 8,400 square feet to the facility and related capital improvements and equipment costs (the “2026 Project”), and (b) up to \$3,300,000 to refinance the Corporation’s outstanding loan currently held by PNC Bank, N.A., which was incurred to finance the construction of the Corporation’s clinic located at 6029 N. Winton Way in the City of Winton, California (the “2018 Project” and, collectively with the 2026 Project, the “Project”), (c) pay the capitalized interest of the Bonds, and (d) pay costs in connection with the issuance of the Bonds and fund a reserve fund for the Bonds. The Project is and will be owned and operated by the Corporation, an organization described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 A.M. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, and will be held in Room 440, 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California.
