

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the Capital Programs and Climate Financing Authority (the "Authority"), or a designee, on Thursday, May 21, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., Pacific Time, or as soon thereafter as such matters may be heard, in Room 389 of 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California 95814, on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of tax-exempt revenue notes in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$3,545,000 (the "Notes") on behalf of Kochergen Farms Composting, Inc., a California corporation, and/or its affiliates (collectively, the "Company"). The Notes will constitute qualified private activity bonds as defined in Section 142(a)(6) of the Code for the purpose of financing solid waste disposal facilities.

A portion of the proceeds of the Notes, in an amount not to exceed \$2,050,000, will finance a portion of the costs of the construction of a transfer station and site improvements to be located at 2908/2962 S. Cedar Avenue, Fresno, California 93725.

A portion of the proceeds of the Notes, in an amount not to exceed \$1,450,000, will finance site improvements, including detention ponds, drainage ditches and monitoring wells, at an existing compost facility located at 33915 Avenal Cutoff Road, Kettleman City, California 93239.

All financed assets will be owned and/or operated by Kochergen Farms Composting, Inc., a California corporation.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the proposed financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether the Notes should be issued.
