

RESOLUTION NO. 26-20

APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL SOUNDNESS DETERMINATION FOR SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ON BEHALF OF HARRIET TUBMAN VILLAGE CHARTER FOR PRELIMINARY APPORTIONMENT UNDER THE PROPOSITION 2 FUNDING ROUND OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL FACILITIES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Charter School Facilities Program (Program) was established for the purpose of providing charter schools with funding to construct new facilities and rehabilitate existing district facilities; and

WHEREAS, modeled after the State's School Facilities Program, the Program funds 50 percent of project costs as a grant from the State, and the other 50 percent is funded through a local match, which can be met with a lump sum payment from the grantee or through a loan from the State to the grantee; and

WHEREAS, in November 2024, voters approved Proposition 2, a ballot measure which allocated an additional \$600 million to the Program; and

WHEREAS, the California School Finance Authority (Authority) and the State Allocation Board (Board), staffed by the Office of Public School Construction (OPSC), are designated to jointly administer the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is authorized by Education Code section 17078.57 and section 10154 of Program regulations to determine whether applicants to the Program are financially sound for purposes of the Program at the time of Preliminary, Advance, and Final Apportionment; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Unified School District (SDUSD) applied for Proposition 2 funding, pledging to satisfy the lump sum payment with General Obligation bond proceeds, on behalf of Harriet Tubman Village Charter (HTVC); and the Authority has conducted a financial soundness review of San Diego Unified School District (SDUSD) on behalf of Harriet Tubman Village Charter (HTVC) and determined HTVC is financially sound for purposes of Preliminary Apportionment; and

WHEREAS, this determination of financial soundness will be provided to the Office of Public School Construction in connection with the State Allocation Board's consideration of a Preliminary Apportionment to SDUSD on behalf of HTVC in the amount of \$14,488,414.00 for its project consisting of New Construction/ Rehabilitation of the HTVC's current school facility located in San Diego County (Project); and

WHEREAS, SDUSD will fulfill the project's local matching share obligation by providing a lump sum in the amount of \$14,488,414.00; and

WHEREAS, this determination of financial soundness is contingent upon there being no material legal, financial, or operational changes that impact negatively HTVC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the California School Finance Authority as follows:

Section 1. That SDUSD on behalf of HTVC has demonstrated its financial soundness for purposes of Preliminary Apportionment.

Section 2. The Executive Director of the Authority, the Chair, or their respective designees are hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the Authority, to notify the State Allocation Board and the Office of Public School Construction and provide supporting documentation, that SDUSD on behalf of HTVC has demonstrated its financial soundness for purposes of Preliminary Apportionment.

Section 3. The Executive Director of the Authority, the Chair, or their respective designees are hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the Authority, to execute the Program Agreements between the State and SDUSD on behalf of HTVC.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval and be in effect for twelve months from the date of adoption.

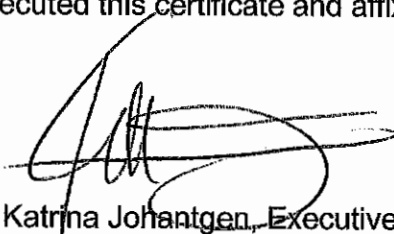
